Web Based Management (web browser)

The Brother print server is equipped with a web server that allows you to monitor its status or change some of its configuration settings, using HTTP (Hyper Text Transfer Protocol).



- The login name for the Administrator is '**admin**' (case sensitive) and the default password is '**access**'.
- We recommend Microsoft[®] Internet Explorer[®] 6.0 (or greater) or Firefox 1.0 (or greater) for Windows[®] and Safari 1.3 (or greater) for Macintosh. Please also make sure that JavaScript and Cookies are always enabled in whichever browser you use. To use a web browser, you will need to know the IP Address of the print server. The IP Address of the print server is listed on the Printer Settings Page.

To reset all network settings of the print server to its factory default, follow the steps below.

- C Hold down Go as you turn on the power switch. Keep Go pressed down until the all LEDs light up and then Status LED turns up. Release Go. Make sure that all the LEDs turn off.
- Press Go six times. Make sure that all the LEDs light up to indicate the print server has been reset to its default settings. The printer will restart.

Print the Printer Settings Page

The Printer Settings Page lists all the current printer settings, including network settings. To print the printer settings page:

- A Make sure that the front cover is closed and the power cord is plugged in.
