



## Install the Drum Unit

- A. Unpack the drum unit assembly, and gently rock it from side to side five or six times to distribute the toner evenly inside the cartridge.
- To prevent damage to the drum, do not expose it to light for longer than a few minutes.
- B. Remove the protective part.



**C.** Open the front cover of the machine.



Insert the drum unit assembly into the machine.




E. Close the front cover.

## **3** How to connect the Optional Paper Tray

A. Carefully pick up the machine and place it on top of the Optional




B. Plug the modular cable from the Lower Tray into the modular jack on the machine.



To select which tray will be used for faxes or for copies, see *Lower Tray (With Optional Paper Tray Only)* and for printer setting, see *Paper Source* in the Owner's Manual on the CD-ROM.


If you move the machine after connecting the Lower Tray, be sure to carefully lift the Lower Tray with the machine because they are not fixed together.


## 5 Load Paper

- A. Pull the paper cassette completely out of the machine.
- B. Adjust the paper guides at the right and rear of the paper cassette for the paper size you want.
- c. Load paper in the paper cassette. Press down on the paper to flatten it in all four corners, keeping the paper level below the guide.
- **D.** Slide the paper cassette into the machine until it locks into place.





Choose the mode that best suits your needs by pressing **Mode** repeatedly until you have changed the FAX and FAX/TEL lights to the setting you want to use.

## Set Date and Time

A. Press Menu, 1, 1.

YEAR:XX

ENTER & SET KEYB. Enter the last two digits of the year and press Set.

MONTH:XX ENTER & SET KEY

**C.** Enter two digits for the month and press **Set**.

DAY:XX ENTER & SET KEY

**D.** Enter two digits for the day and press **Set**.

TIME:XX:XX ENTER & SET KEY

- E. Enter the time in 24-hour format and press
- F. Press Stop/Exit.

Note: If you can't step forward, press **Stop/Exit** and repeat from Step A.

E. Press Stop/Exit.

## Setting Up the MFC and PC to Work Together

### **Before You begin**

- You must set up the hardware and install the Brother Drivers before you can use your MFC as a printer and scanner in any Windows® application.
- Please purchase the appropriate cable if you intend to use USB. Bonus IEEE 1284 Bi-directional parallel cable is included. (USB cable is not included.)
- Use only a shielded parallel interface cable that is IEEE 1284-compliant and/or a USB cable that is no longer than 6 feet long (1.8 meters).

Follow the instructions in this guide for your operating system and interface.

## For Windows® 95/98/98SE/Me/2000 Users

Step 1. Unplug the MFC from the AC outlet and disconnect your MFC from your computer if you have already connected an interface cable.

Step 2. Turn on your computer.

For Windows® 2000 Professional, you must be logged on as the Administrator.

Step 3. Insert the CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive.



Insert the MFC Software Suite CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive. The CD-ROM main menu will appear. If any window does not appear after you insert the CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive, use Windows® Explorer to run the setup.exe program from the root directory of the Brother CD-ROM.






Click MFC Software Suite in Main Application, and then click Install. Please see Note \*1.




4. Click Install.



The InstallShield Wizard Setup window will appear briefly, followed by the PaperPort® Setup window. Click Yes.



When the PaperPort® Setup window displays your Name and Company, either change or accept them, and then click Next.



When the Choose Destination Location window displays the path where the PaperPort® files will be installed, either change or accept, and then click Next.




When the Register Today screen appears, click Next. This is registration for Paper Port®. Follow the instructions.




When the MFC Software Suite Installation window appears, click Next to begin installing the MFC Software Suite. Please see Note \*2.

- \*1 MFC Software Suite includes Printer Driver, Scanner Driver, ScanSoft™ PaperPort®, ScanSoft™ Text Bridge®, PC-FAX software, Remote Setup and True Type fonts. PaperPort® is a document management application for viewing scanned documents. ScanSoft™ TextBridge®, which is integrated into PaperPort®, is an OCR application that converts an image into text and inserts it into your default word processor package.
- \*2 If an error message appears during the installation process, or you have previously installed MFC Software Suite or MFL Pro, you will first have to uninstall it. From the Start menu, select Programs, Brother, Brother MFL Pro, Uninstall, and then follow the instructions on the screen.
- \*3 Even if you select NO, later you will be able to launch the Brother Control Centre to use the Scan keys. See AutoLoad the Brother Control Centre, Chapter 13 in the Owner's Manual on the CD-ROM.

### Step 4. **Connect the MFC to your PC with Parallel Cable.**

- A. Connect the parallel interface cable to the parallel interface port of the MFC and secure the wire clips.
- Connect the interface cable to the printer port of the computer and secure it with the two screws. For the location of your computer's parallel printer port, see the User's Guide for your computer.

Click Yes to have the Control Centre loaded each time Windows® is started. The Control Centre will appear as an icon in the task tray. If you click No the Scan keys on the MFC will be disabled. Please see Note \*3.

The Brother PC fax, Printer and Scanner drivers have been installed and the installation is now complete.

## Step 4.

Turn on the MFC by plugging in the power cord.



The installation of the Brother driver will automatically start. Follow the instructions on the screen.



In the Add Printer Wizard window, select BRUSB: **USB Printer Port**, and then click Next.




If the test page is printed correctly, click Yes. If you click No, follow the prompts on the screen to correct the problem.



Accept the default Printer name by selecting Yes, and then click Next.



Select Yes to restart your computer, and then click Finish.



Select Yes (recommended), and then click Finish. A test page will be printed so you can check the print quality.



Click Yes to have the Control Centre loaded each time Windows® is started. The Control Centre will appear as an icon in the task tray. If you click No the Scan keys on the MFC will be disabled. Please see Note \*3.





When the **Digital Signature Not** Found dialog boxes appear, click Yes to install the driver.



Select Finish to restart your computer.



Click **Yes** to have the Control Centre loaded each time Windows® is started. The Control Centre will appear as an icon in the task tray. If you click No the Scan keys on the MFC will be disabled. Please see Note \*3.




