

## **Carton Components**

■ USB interface cable

Please make sure you use a USB 2.0 interface cable that is no longer than 6 feet (2.0 meters). When you use a USB cable, make sure you connect it to the USB port of your computer and not to a USB port on a keyboard or non-powered USB hub.

Do NOT connect the interface cable at this time.









For Legal size paper, press in the inside latches and pull out the back of the paper tray.




Fan the stack of paper well to avoid paper jams and misfeeds.



Put paper in the paper tray. Check that the paper is flat in the tray and below the maximum paper mark.






### Warning

- The MFC must be grounded using a 3-prong plug.
- Since the MFC is grounded through the power outlet, you can protect yourself from potentially hazardous electrical conditions on the telephone network by keeping the power cord connected to your MFC when you connect it to a telephone line. Similarly, you can protect yourself when you want to move your MFC by disconnecting the telephone line first and then the power cord.



If you are sharing one phone line with an external telephone, connect it as shown below.








- Follow the on-screen instructions, and restart your Macintosh®.
- After the **DeviceSelector** window appears, connect the USB interface cable to your Macintosh® and then to the MFC.






The **DeviceSelector** window will not appear if you have connected a USB interface cable to the MFC before restarting your Macintosh®or if you are overwriting a previously installed version of the Brother software. If you encounter this problem continue with the installation but skip step 9. You should select your Brother machine from the Model pulldown list in the main screen of ControlCenter2.0.





DO NOT connect the MFC to a USB port on a keyboard or a non-powered USB hub.


8 Plug in the power cord and turn on the MFC.

12 Open the Print Setup Utility icon.




For Mac OS<sup>®</sup> X 10.2.x users, open **Print Center** icon.

Select Quit Printer Setup Utility from the Printer Setup Utility menu.






The MFL-Pro Suite, Printer driver, Scanner driver and ControlCenter2.0 have been installed.



# For Mac OS<sup>®</sup> 9.1 to 9.2

Make sure that you have completed the instructions from Step 1 "Setting Up the MFC" on pages 4 - 11.

Turn off and unplug the MFC from the AC outlet.

- Insert the supplied CD-ROM for Macintosh<sup>®</sup> into your CD-ROM drive.




4 Double-click the **Start Here OS 9.1-9.2** icon to install the printer driver. If the language screen appears, select your language.




5 Click MFL-Pro Suite to install.

9 Open the **Chooser** from the **Apple** menu.







# For Network Interface Cable Users (MFC-7225N only)

Olick the **Brother Laser (IP)** icon, and then select BRN\_XXXXXX. Close the Chooser.





XXXXXX are the last six digits of the Ethernet address.



The MFL-Pro Suite and Printer driver have been installed.



# For Mac OS® X 10.2.4 or greater

Make sure that you have completed the instructions from Step 1 "Setting Up the MFC" on pages 4 - 11.

1 Turn off and unplug the MFC from the AC outlet.



- 2 Turn on your Macintosh®.
- If you are using the optional NC-2200w
  External Wireless Print/Scan Server, follow
  installation steps 1 to 3 in the NC-2200w
  Quick Setup Guide first.
- Insert the supplied CD-ROM for Macintosh<sup>®</sup> into your CD-ROM drive.



4 Double-click the **Start Here OSX** icon to install the drivers and MFL-Pro Suite. If the language screen appears, select your language.



5 Click **MFL-Pro Suite** to install.





- 6 Follow the on-screen instructions, and restart your Macintosh<sup>®</sup>.

The **DeviceSelector** window will not appear if you have also connected a USB interface cable to the MFC before restarting your Macintosh<sup>®</sup> or if you are overwriting a previously installed version of the Brother software. If you encounter this problem continue with the installation skipping steps 9 to 11 and then see the Software User's Guide for details on selecting which MFC the ControlCenter2.0 will connect with.





Select **Network** and then click **OK**.




Click Browse.

16 Make the selection shown below.




Select Brother MFC-7225N and then click the Add button.


BRAdmin Professional can also be used to manage devices from other manufacturers whose products support SNMP (Simple Network Management Protocol).






The default password for the print server is "access". You can use BRAdmin Professional or a web browser to change this password.


# Setting your IP Address, Subnet Mask and Gateway using BRAdmin Professional (Windows® Users Only)

Start BRAdmin Professional, and select TCP/IP.




Select Search Active Devices from the Devices menu.
