An interface cable is not a standard accessory. Buy the proper interface cable for the interface you want to use (USB or network).

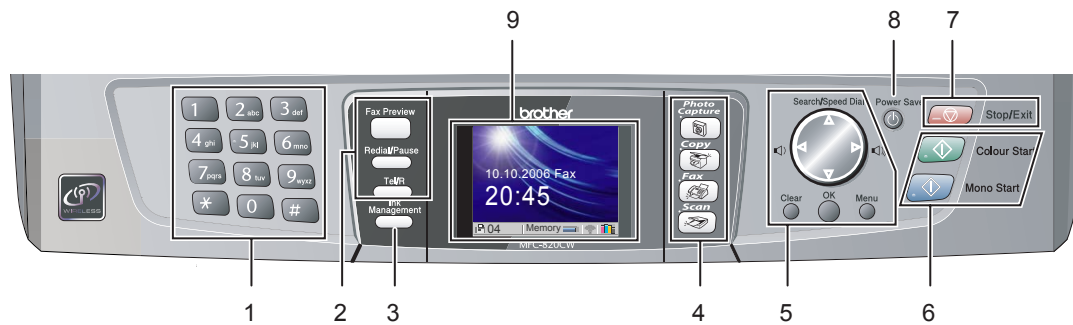
USB cable

- Please make sure you use a USB 2.0 cable that is no longer than 6 feet long (2 metres).
- Your MFC has a USB interface that is compatible with the USB 2.0 specification.
- DO NOT connect the interface cable at this time.
Connecting the interface cable is done during the software installation process.

Network cable

- Use a straight-through Category5 (or greater) twisted-pair cable for 10BASE-T or 100BASE-TX Fast Ethernet Network.

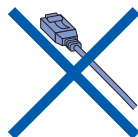
1 Removing the protective parts

- 1 Remove the protective tape, then, starting from the left hand side, carefully remove the scanner glass protection sheet.

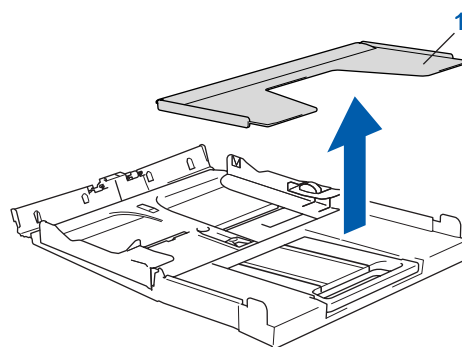
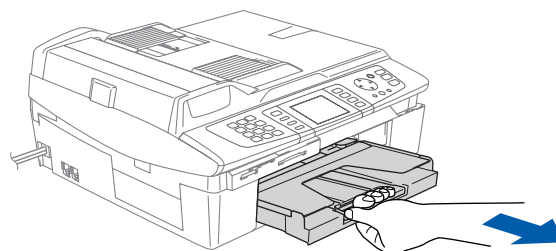

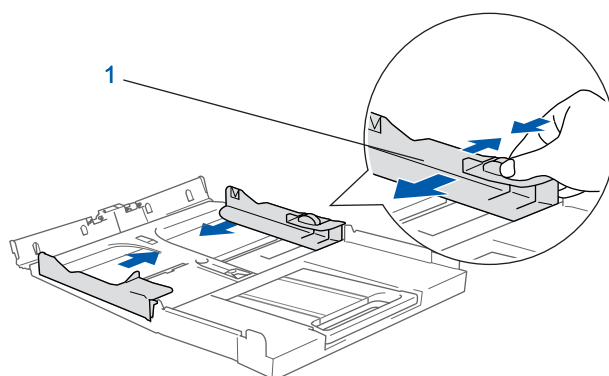
2 Loading paper

- 🔍** You can load up to 100 sheets of 80 g/m² (20 lb) paper.
 For details, see About paper in Chapter 2 of the User's Guide.

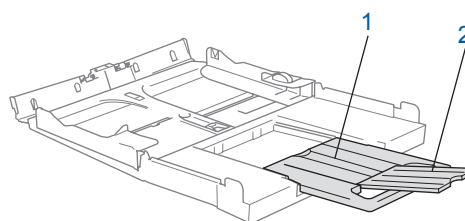
- 1 Pull the paper tray completely out of the machine and remove the output paper tray (1).



- 2 Press and slide the paper guide (1) to fit the paper width.



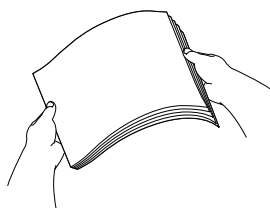
- 3 Pull out the paper support (1) and unfold the paper support flap (2).



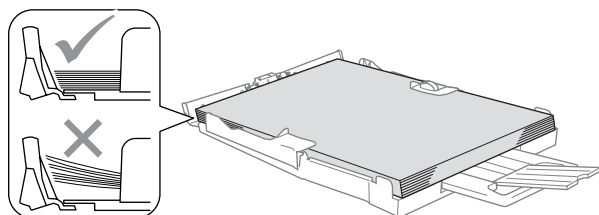
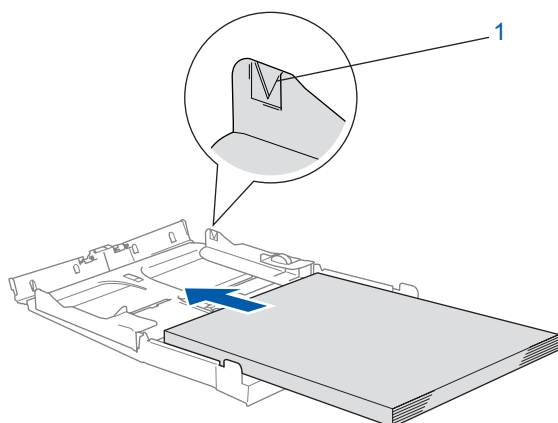
Note

Use the paper support flap for Letter, Legal and A4 paper.

- 4** Fan the stack of paper well to avoid paper jams and misfeeds.



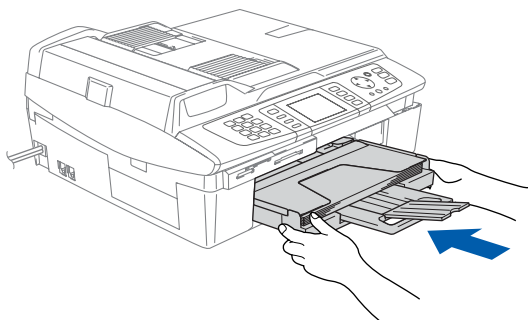
- 5** Gently put the paper into the paper tray print side down and top edge first. Check that the paper is flat in the tray and below the maximum paper mark (1).



Note

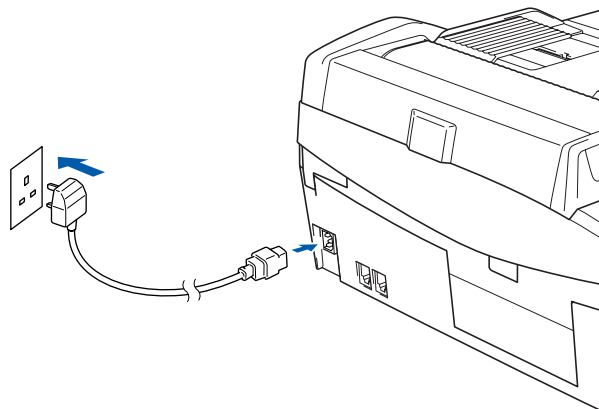
- Make sure the paper side guides touch the sides of the paper.
- Be careful that you do not push the paper in too far; it may lift at the back of the tray and cause paper feed problems.

- 6** Put the output paper tray back on and push the paper tray firmly back into the machine.

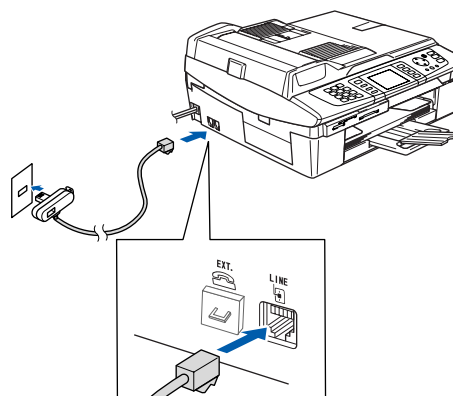


3 Installing the phone line and power cord

- 1** Connect the power cord.



- 2** Connect the telephone line cord. Connect one end of the telephone line cord to the socket on the machine marked **LINE** and the other end to a modular wall socket.

DO NOT connect the USB cable. Connecting the USB cable is done during the software installation process.

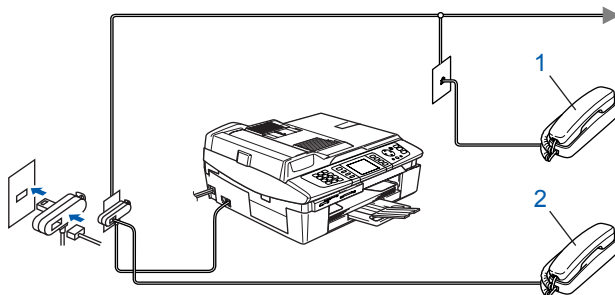
- The machine must be fitted with an earthed plug.
- Since the machine is grounded through the power outlet, you can protect yourself from potentially hazardous electrical conditions on the telephone network by keeping the power cord connected to your machine when you connect it to a telephone line. Similarly, you can protect yourself when you want to move your machine by disconnecting the telephone line first and then the power cord.

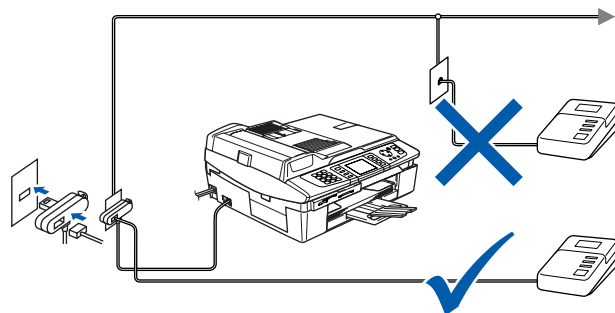

Installing the ink cartridges

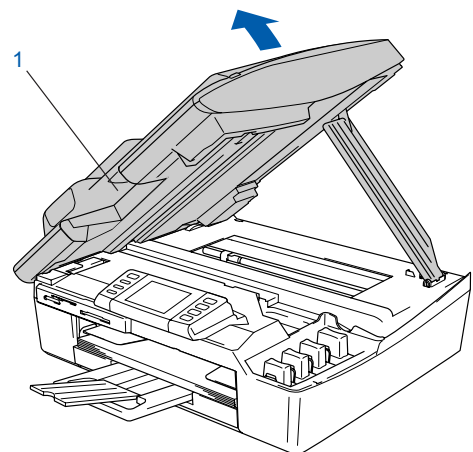

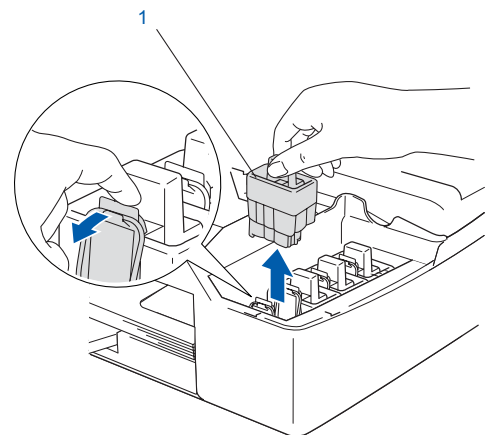

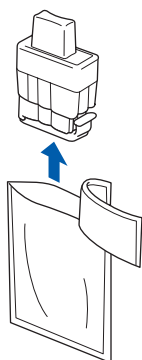
Remove the yellow protective parts (1).



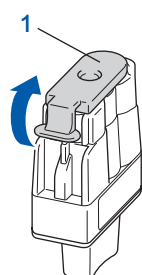

- 4** Take out the ink cartridge.

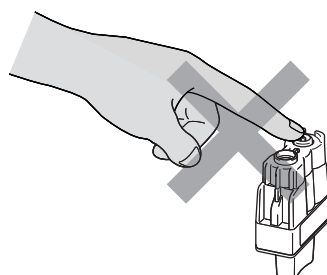


- 5** Carefully remove the protective yellow cap (1).

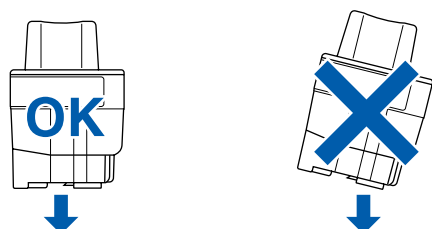

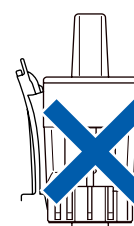
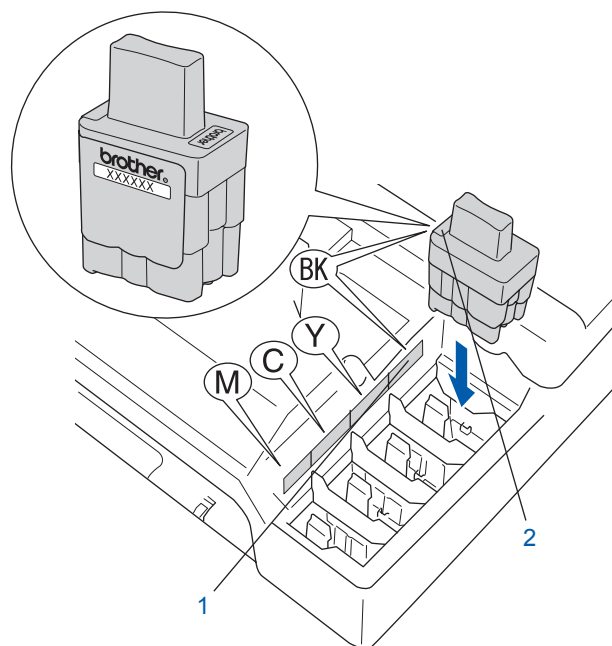

If the protective yellow cap comes off when you open the bag, the cartridge will not be damaged.

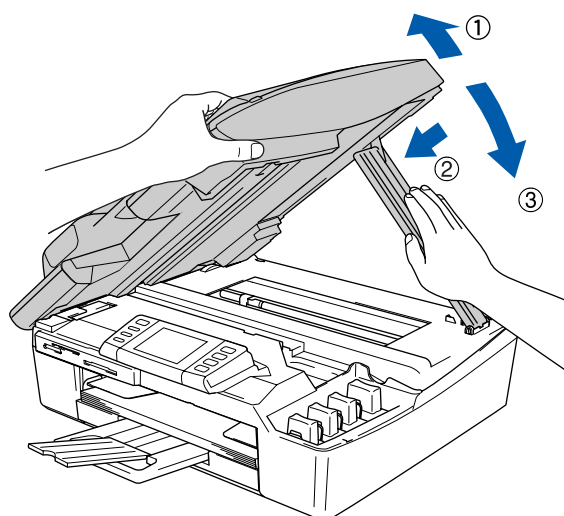
Keep the ink cartridge in an upright position when you put it into the slot.



- 6** Press firmly down on the ink cartridge until the hook snaps over it, taking care to match the slot colour (1) with the cartridge colour (2), as shown in the diagram below.



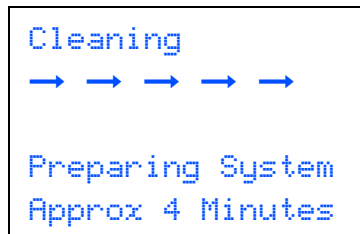
- 7** Lift the scanner cover to release the lock. Gently push the scanner cover support down and close the scanner cover.



📝 Note

If the LCD still shows Black, Yellow, Cyan or Magenta after you install the ink cartridges, check that the ink cartridges are installed properly.

The machine will clean the ink tube system for use for the first time. This process will occur only once, the first time ink cartridges are installed. The cleaning process will last approximately four minutes. The LCD shows:

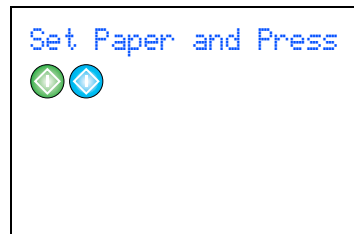


! Caution

- DO NOT take out ink cartridges if you do not need to replace them. If you do so, it may reduce the ink quantity and the machine will not know the quantity of ink left in the cartridge.
- DO NOT shake the ink cartridges. If ink stains your skin or clothing, wash with soap or detergent at once.
- DO NOT repeatedly insert and remove the cartridges. If you do so, ink may seep out of the cartridge.
- If you mix the colours by installing an ink cartridge in the wrong position, clean the print head several times after correcting the cartridge installation. (See *Cleaning the print head in Appendix B of the User's Guide.*)
- Once you open an ink cartridge, install it in the machine and use it up within six months of installation. Use unopened ink cartridges by the expiration date written on the cartridge package.
- DO NOT dismantle or tamper with the ink cartridge, this can cause the ink to leak out of the cartridge.
- Brother multifunction machines are designed to work with ink of a particular specification and will work to a level of optimum performance when used with genuine Brother branded ink cartridges. Brother cannot guarantee this optimum performance if ink or ink cartridges of other specifications are used. Brother does not therefore recommend the use of cartridges other than genuine Brother branded cartridges with this machine or the refilling of empty cartridges with ink from other sources. If damage is caused to the print head or other parts of this machine as a result of using incompatible products with this machine, any repairs required as a result may not be covered by the warranty.

5 Print quality check

- 1 After the cleaning cycle is finished, the LCD shows:

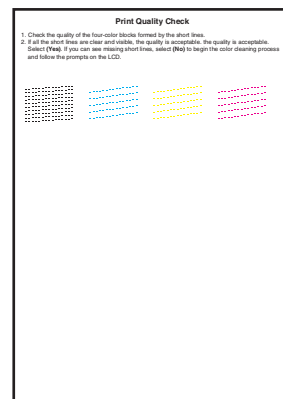


- 2 Make sure the paper is loaded in the paper tray.

Press **Colour Start**.

The machine starts printing the Print Quality Check Sheet (only during initial ink cartridge installation).

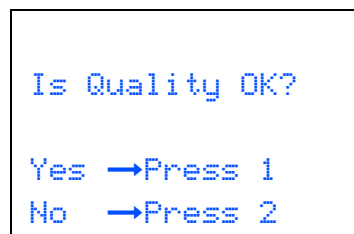
- 3 Check the quality of the four colour blocks on the sheet.
(black/ cyan/ yellow/ magenta)

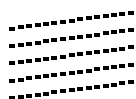
Avoid touching the printed surface of the paper immediately after printing, the surface may not be completely dry and may stain your fingers.

- 4 The LCD shows:

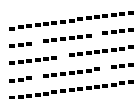


- 5** Do one of the following:
- If all lines are clear and visible, press **1** (Yes) on the dial pad to finish the quality check.
 - If you can see missing short lines, press **2** (No) on the dial pad and go to step **6**.

- 6** The LCD asks you if the print quality is OK for black and colour. Press **1** (Yes) or **2** (No) on the dial pad.

No → Press 2

After pressing **1** (Yes) or **2** (No) for both black and colour, the LCD shows:

Start Cleaning?

Yes → Press 1
No → Press 2

- 7** Press **1** (Yes), the machine will then start cleaning the colours.

- 8** After cleaning is finished, press **Colour Start**. The machine starts printing the Print Quality Check Sheet again and goes back to step **3**.

6 Setting the date and time

The machine displays the date and time, and prints it on every fax sent, if the station ID has been setup.

- 1** Press **Menu**.
- 2** Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Initial Setup**. Press **OK**.
- 3** Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Date/Time**. Press **OK**.
- 4** Enter the last two digits of the year on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

(e.g. Enter **0 6** for 2006.)

- 5** Enter the two digits for the month on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

(e.g. Enter **0 3** for March.)

- 6** Enter the two digits for the day on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

(e.g. Enter **0 1** for the first of the month.)

- 7** Enter the time in 24-hour format on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

(e.g. Enter **1 5, 2 5** for 3:25 P.M.)

- 8** Press **Stop/Exit**.

7 Setting your station ID

You should store your name and fax number to be printed on all fax pages that you send.

- 1 Press **Menu**.
- 2 Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Initial Setup**. Press **OK**.
- 3 Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Station ID**. Press **OK**.
- 4 Enter your fax number (up to 20 digits) on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

8 Setting tone or pulse dialling mode

- 1 Press **Menu**.
- 2 Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Initial Setup**. Press **OK**.
- 3 Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Tone/Pulse**. Press **OK**.
- 4 Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Pulse (or Tone)**. Press **OK**.
- 5 Press **Stop/Exit**.

9 Setting the phone line type

If you are connecting the machine to a line that features PBX or ISDN to send and receive faxes, it is also necessary to change the phone line type accordingly by completing the following steps.

- 1** Press **Menu**.
- 2** Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Initial Setup**. Press **OK**.
- 3** Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Phone Line Set**. Press **OK**.
- 4** Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **PBX, ISDN (or Normal)**. Press **OK**.
- 5** Press **Stop/Exit**.

PBX and TRANSFER

The machine is initially set to Normal, which lets the machine connect to a standard PSTN (Public Switched Telephone Network) line. However, many offices use a central telephone system or Private Automatic Branch Exchange (PBX). Your machine can be connected to most types of PABX. The machine's recall feature supports timed break recall only (TBR). TBR will work with most PABX systems allowing you to gain access to an outside line or send calls to another extension. The feature works when the **Tel/R** key is pressed.

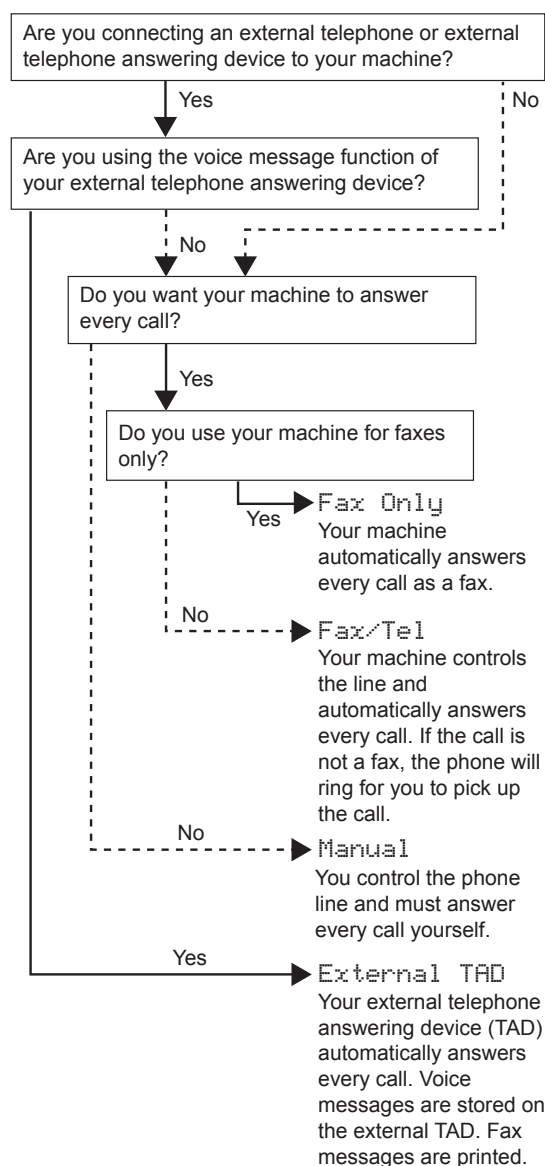


Note

You can program a **Tel/R** key press as part of a number stored in a **Speed-Dial** location. When programming the **Speed-Dial** number, press **Tel/R** first (the LCD shows '!'), then enter the telephone number. If you do this, you do not need to press **Tel/R** each time before you dial using a **Speed-Dial** location. (See *Storing numbers for easy dialling on the User's Guide*.)

10 Choosing a Receive Mode

There are four possible receive modes: **Fax Only**, **Fax/Tel**, **Manual** and **External TAD**.



- 1** Press **Menu**.
- 2** Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Initial Setup**. Press **OK**.
- 3** Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Receive Mode**. Press **OK**.
- 4** Press **▲** or **▼** to choose the mode. Press **OK**.
- 5** Press **Stop/Exit**.



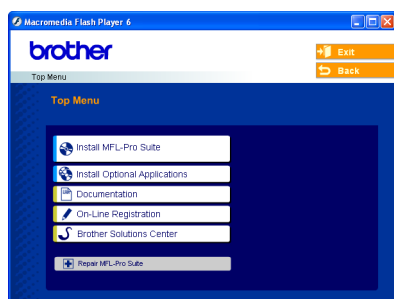

If you have setup wireless networking on your machine before and you setup the wired network, you should check that the machine's Network I/F is Wired LAN. The wireless network interface will be inactive with this setting.

On your machine, press Menu.

Press ▲ or ▼ to choose LAN and press OK.

Press ▲ or ▼ to choose Network I/F and press OK.

Press ▲ or ▼ to choose Wired LAN and press OK.

Press 1 for Yes to accept the change. The machine will restart automatically.

- Most access points and routers can store more than one key, but they will only use one at any time for authentication and encryption.

See Chapter 3 of the Network User's Guide for more details.

- 2** Turn on the machine by plugging in the power cord.



⚠ Improper Setup

If you have previously configured the wireless settings of the machine you must reset the network (LAN) settings before you can configure the wireless settings again. On your machine, press **Menu**. Press **▲** or **▼** for **LAN** and press **OK**. Press **▲** or **▼** for **Factory Reset** and press **OK**. Press **1** twice for **Yes** to accept the change. The machine will restart automatically.

- 3** On your machine, press **Menu**. Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **LAN** and press **OK**. Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Network I/F** and press **OK**. Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **WLAN** and press **OK**. Press **1** for **Yes** to accept the change. If **Accepted** is displayed, press **Stop/Exit**. The wired network interface will become inactive with this setting.

It will take about a minute for the LAN menu on the LCD to become available again.

- 4** When the LAN menu becomes available, press **Menu**. Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **LAN** and press **OK**. Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Setup WLAN** and press **OK**. Press **▲** or **▼** to choose **Setup Wizard** and press **OK**. This will start the wireless setup wizard.

- 5** The machine will search for your network and display a list of available SSIDs. You should see the SSID you wrote down earlier. If the machine finds more than one network use the **▲** or **▼** keys to choose your network, then press **OK**.

- 6** Use the **▲**, **▼** and **OK** keys to choose one of the options below: If your network is configured for Authentication and Encryption you must match the settings used for your network.

No Authentication or Encryption: Choose **Open System**, press **OK** then choose **None** for **Encryption Type?** and press **OK**. Then press **1 Yes** to apply your settings. Go to step **9**.

No Authentication with WEP Encryption: Choose **Open System**, press **OK** then use the **▲** or **▼** to choose **WEP** for the **Encryption Type?** and press **OK**. Go to step **7**.

Authentication with WEP Encryption: Choose **Shared Key**, press **OK**. Go to step **7**.

Authentication with WPA-PSK (TKIP) Encryption: Choose **WPA-PSK**, press **OK**. Go to step **8**.

- 7** Choose the appropriate key number and press **OK**. Enter the WEP key you wrote down in step **1** using the dial pad. You can use the **◀** and **▶** keys to move the cursor. For example, to enter the letter **a**, press the **2** key on the dial pad once. To enter the number **3**, press the **3** key on the dial pad seven times. The letters appear in this order: lower case, upper case, numbers and then special letters.

Press **OK** when you have entered all the characters, then press **1 Yes** to apply your settings. Go to step **9**.

- 8** Enter the WPA-PSK (TKIP) key you wrote down in step **1** using the dial pad. You can use the **◀** and **▶** keys to move the cursor. For example, to enter the letter **a**, press the **2** key on the dial pad once. To enter the number **3**, press the **3** key on your dial pad seven times.

Press **OK** when you have entered all the characters, then press **1 Yes** to apply your settings. Go to step **9**.

- 9** Your machine will now try to connect to your wireless network using the information you have entered. If successful, **Connected** will appear briefly on the LCD.

*If your machine does not successfully connect to your network, you should repeat steps **3** to **8** to make sure you have entered the correct information.*

- 10** Disconnect and then reconnect the power cord to turn the machine OFF and back ON. This will allow the machine to automatically acquire the correct TCP/IP address information from your access point (router) if DHCP is enabled (DHCP is normally enabled as default for most access point routers).

If your access point does not have DHCP enabled you will need to manually configure the IP address, subnet mask and gateway of the machine to suit your network. See the Network User's Guide for details.

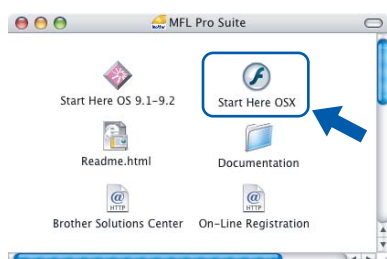
