# For Wireless Network Interface Users



## Before you begin

First you **must** configure the wireless network settings of your printer to communicate with your network access point/router. After the printer is configured to communicate with your access point/router computers on your network will have access to the printer. To use the printer from these computers, you will need to install the printer driver. The following steps will guide you through the configuration and installation process.



- To achieve optimum results with normal everyday document printing, place the Brother printer as close to the network access point/router as possible with minimal obstructions. Large objects and walls between the two devices as well as interference from other electronic devices can affect the data transfer speed of your documents.
- Due to these factors, wireless may not be the best method of connection for all types of documents and applications. If you are printing large files, such as multi-page documents with mixed text and large graphics, you may want to consider choosing wired Ethernet or parallel for a faster data transfer, or USB for the fastest throughput speed.
- Although the Brother HL-5370DW can be used in a both wired and wireless network, only one of the connection methods can be used at a time.
- The following instructions will offer two methods for installing your Brother printer in a wireless network environment. Both methods are for infrastructure mode, using a wireless access point/router that uses DHCP to assign IP Addresses. Choose your setup method from the next page and follow the instructions. To set up your printer in any other wireless environment (e.g. Ad-hoc mode) you can find instructions in the Network User's Guide on the CD-ROM.



- 1 Turn on your computer. Insert the Brother CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive.





<sup>1</sup> WPA/WPA2-PSK is a Wi-Fi Protected Access Pre-Shared Key, which lets the Brother wireless machine associate with access points using TKIP or AES encryption (WPA-Personal). WPA/WPA2-PSK (TKIP or AES) uses a Pre-Shared Key (PSK) that is 8 or more characters in length, up to a maximum of 63 characters.

<sup>2</sup> The WEP key is for 64-bit encrypted networks or 128-bit encrypted networks and can contain both numbers and letters. If you do not know this information you should see the documentation provided with your access point or wireless router. This key is a 64-bit or 128-bit value that must be entered in an ASCII or HEXADECIMAL format.

64-bit ASCII:	Uses 5 text characters e.g. "Hello" (this is case sensitive)
64-bit Hexadecimal:	Uses 10 digits of hexadecimal data e.g. "71f2234aba"

- Press Go six times. Make sure that all the LEDs light up to indicate the print server has been reset to its default settings. The printer will restart.

### **Print the Printer Settings Page**

The Printer Settings Page lists all the current printer settings, including network settings. To print the printer settings page:

- A Make sure that the front cover is closed and the power cord is plugged in.
- Turn on the printer and wait until the printer is in the Ready state.
- C Press **Go** three times within 2 seconds. The printer will print the current printer settings page.


### Safety precautions
