## Automatic Daylight Savings Time



You can set the machine to change automatically for daylight savings time. It will reset itself forward one hour in the spring and backward one hour in the fall.

### Before you begin

Although your Brother machine can be used in both a wired and wireless network, only one of the connection methods can be used at a time.

#### Note

*If you have previously configured the wireless settings of the machine you must reset the network settings before you can configure the wireless settings again.*

On your machine, press  and **Network**.

Swipe up or down, or press **▲** or **▼** to display **Network Reset**, and then press **Network Reset**.

Press **Yes** to accept. Hold down **Yes** for 2 seconds to confirm.

#### Note

*To set up your machine in Ad-hoc mode (connected to a wireless capable computer without an access point/router) you can find instructions in the Network User's Guide on the DVD-ROM.*

### Choose your wireless setup method

The following instructions will offer three methods for setting up your Brother machine on a wireless network. Choose the method you prefer for your environment.

#### **a** Setup using the installation DVD-ROM and a USB cable (Windows® & Macintosh)

You need to temporarily use a USB cable during configuration.

It is recommended that you use a computer wirelessly connected to your network for this method.

**If you are using Windows® XP, or currently using a computer connected to an access point/router by network cable, you need to know your wireless settings. Please write down your wireless network settings in the area on page 12.**

### How can I find this information?

- 2) The default SSID could be the manufacturer's name or the model name.
- 3) If you do not know the security information, please consult the router manufacturer, your system administrator or internet provider.

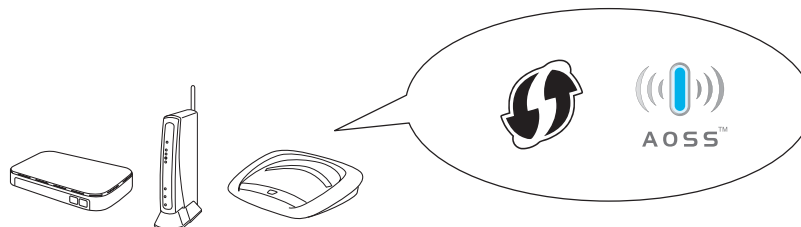

## 10 Setup using the installation DVD-ROM and a USB cable (Windows® & Macintosh)



### Note

This example shows Windows® installation. For Mac installation, insert the installation DVD-ROM into your DVD-ROM drive and double-click **Start Here OSX** to install. Select **Wireless installation** and follow the **Wireless Device Setup** instructions on your computer screen.

**a** Put the supplied DVD-ROM into your DVD-ROM drive. If the model name screen appears, choose your machine. If the language screen appears, choose your language.

**b** The DVD-ROM Top Menu will appear. Click **Install MFL-Pro Suite** and click **Yes** if you accept the license agreements. Follow the on-screen instructions.

**c** Choose **Wireless Network Connection**, and then click **Next**.

**d** When **Firewall/AntiVirus detected** screen appears, choose **Change the Firewall port settings to enable network connection and continue with the installation. (Recommended)** and click **Next**.

If you are using a firewall other than the Windows® Firewall, see the instructions provided with your firewall software for information on how to add the following network ports.

- For network scanning, add UDP port 54925.
- If you still have trouble with your network connection, add UDP port 137 and 161.

**e** Choose **Yes, I have a USB cable to use for installation.** and then click **Next**.



### Note

If the **Important Notice** appears, check the box after you confirm the SSID and Network Key, and then click **Next**.



Temporarily connect the USB cable directly to the computer and the machine.

If the confirmation screen appears, check the box and click **Next**, go to **g**. Otherwise, go to **h**.

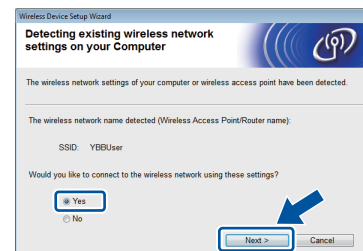


### Note

For instructions on connecting the USB cable to the USB port of your machine, see **Connect the USB cable** on page 6.



**g** When the following screen appears, check **Yes** if you want to connect to the listed SSID. Click **Next** and go to **j**.



**h** When the following screen appears, the wizard will search for wireless networks available to your machine. Choose the SSID that you wrote down for your network in step **9-a** on page 11, and then click **Next**.



### Note

- If the list is blank, check that the access point has power and is broadcasting the SSID, and then see if the machine and the access point are within range for wireless communication. Then click **Refresh**.
- If your access point is set to not broadcast the SSID you can manually add it by clicking the **Advanced** button. Follow the on-screen instructions for entering the **Name (SSID)**, and then click **Next**.



# For Wireless Network Users

- i** Enter the **Network Key** you wrote down in step **9-a** on page 11, and then click **Next**.



## Note

*If your network is not configured for Authentication and Encryption, the following screen will appear. To continue configuration, click **OK** and go to **j**.*



- j** Click **Next**. The settings will be sent to your machine.



## Note

- The settings will remain unchanged if you click **Cancel**.
- If you want to manually enter the IP address settings of your machine, click **Change IP Address** and enter the necessary IP address settings for your network.
- If the wireless setup failure screen appears, click **Retry** and try starting from step **h** again.

- k** Disconnect the USB cable between the computer and the machine.

- l** Click **Next** to continue to install MFL-Pro Suite.



**Wireless setup is now complete. A four level indicator at the top of your machine's LCD will show the wireless signal strength of your access point/router.**

## 10 Manual setup from the control panel using the Setup Wizard (Macintosh, mobile devices and Windows®)

You cannot configure an enterprise wireless network using the Setup Wizard from the control panel. If you choose the SSID for configuring an enterprise wireless network after searching the available SSIDs, the message dialog about Enterprise Authentication Method will appear.

To configure an enterprise wireless network, use installer DVD-ROM and follow the instructions.

- a** Press .  
Swipe up or down, or press ▲ or ▼ to display **Network**, and then press **Network**.  
Swipe up or down, or press ▲ or ▼ to display **WLAN**, and then press **WLAN**.  
Swipe up or down, or press ▲ or ▼ to display **Setup Wizard**, and then press **Setup Wizard**.

When **Enable WLAN?** is displayed, press **Yes** to accept.

This will start the wireless setup wizard.  
To cancel, press **No**.

- b** The machine will search for available SSIDs. It will take several seconds to display a list of available SSIDs.  
If a list of SSIDs is displayed, swipe up or down, or press ▲ or ▼ to choose the SSID you wrote down in step **9-b** on page 12. Select the SSID you want to connect with, then press **OK**.

If the wireless access point/router of the selected SSID supports WPS and the machine asks to use WPS, go to **c**.

If the machine asks you to enter a Network Key, go to **d**.  
Otherwise, go to **e**.



### Note



- If a list of SSIDs is not displayed, make sure your access point is on. Move your machine closer to the access point and try starting from **a** again.
- If your access point is set to not broadcast the SSID, you will have to manually add the SSID name. For details, see the Network User's Guide.

- c** Press **Yes** to connect your machine using WPS. (If you choose **No (Manual)** to continue manual configuration, go to **d** to enter a Network Key.)

When the LCD shows **Start WPS**, press the WPS button on your wireless access point/router, and then press **Next** to proceed.

Go to **e**.

- d** Enter the Network Key you wrote down in step **9-b** on page 12 using the Touchscreen.

Press  **aA** to cycle between lower case and upper case. Press  to cycle between letters, numbers and special characters. (The characters available may differ depending on your country.) To move the cursor to the left or right, press ◀ or ▶.  
(For more information, see *Entering Text for Wireless Settings* on page 21.)

Press **OK** when you have entered all the characters, then press **Yes** to apply your settings.

- e** Your machine will now try to connect to your wireless network. It may take a few minutes.

- f** A connection result message appears until the **OK** button is pressed on the LCD.  
If your wireless device is connected successfully, the LCD shows **Connected**.  
If the connection failed, the LCD shows an error code.



**Wireless setup is now complete. A four level indicator at the top of your machine's LCD will show the wireless signal strength of your access point/router.**

# How to scan to a computer

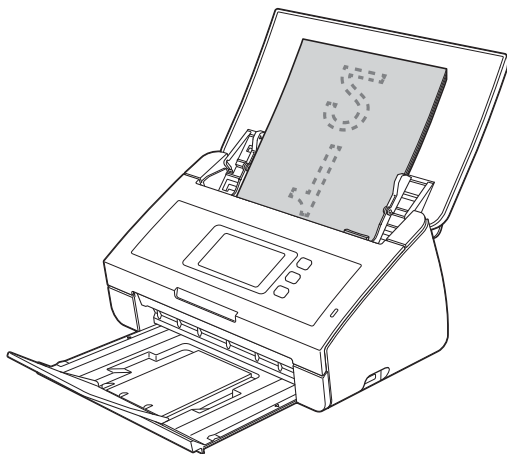
### Scanning a document

There are various scanning methods (see *Scanning Methods* in the *User's Guide*). With the following Scan to File feature, you can scan and save documents as PDF files.

To scan documents and configure various settings, please ensure you have installed the driver and connected the machine to your computer by following the instructions in this guide.

**a** Confirm that the machine is connected to your computer.

**b** Load your document.



**c** Swipe left or right, or press ◀ or ▶ to display Scan 1.

**d** Press to PC.

**e** Swipe left or right to select to File and then press OK.

**f** Select the destination computer you want to save to.

**g** Press Start. The machine starts to feed and scan your document.

The scanned data is saved in PDF format on the computer that is connected to the machine.




#### Note


- You can change Scan to PC settings, such as the saved file format, using ControlCenter. For details, see the *User's Guide* on the DVD-ROM.
- You can use ControlCenter or the scanner driver to initiate scanning from the computer, as well as save scanned data onto a USB flash memory drive connected to the machine. For details, see the *User's Guide* on the DVD-ROM.


## Reset the network settings to factory default

To restore all network settings of the internal Scan server to factory default, please follow the steps below.

- a** Make sure the machine is not operating, then disconnect all the cables from the machine (except the power cord).
- b** Press .
- c** Press `Network`.
- d** Swipe up or down, or press **▲** or **▼** to display `Network Reset`, and then press `Network Reset`.
- e** Press `Yes`.
- f** Hold down `Yes` for 2 seconds to confirm.
- g** The machine will restart, re-connect the cables once this is complete.

## Entering Text for Wireless Settings

Press  to cycle between lower case and upper case.


Press  to cycle between letters, numbers and special characters. (The characters available may differ depending on your country.)

To move the cursor to the left or right, press **◀** or **▶**.

### Inserting spaces

To enter a space, press `Space` button.

### Making corrections

If you entered a character incorrectly and want to change it, move the cursor to the incorrect character. Press  and re-enter the correct character. You can also back up and insert a character.

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
