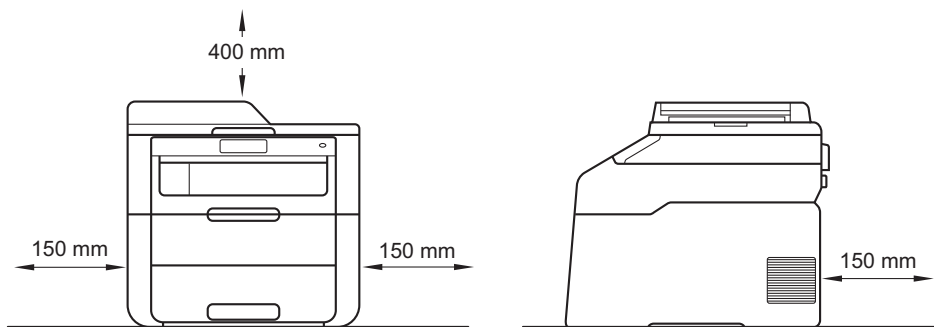
⚠ WARNING

- Plastic bags are used in the packing of your machine. To avoid danger of suffocation, keep these plastic bags away from babies and children. Plastic bags are not toys.
- This machine is heavy and weighs more than 20.0 kg. To prevent possible injuries, at least two people should lift the machine. One person should hold the front of the machine, and one person should hold the back, as shown in the illustration below. Be careful not to trap your fingers when you put the machine down.



NOTE

- Keep a minimum gap around the machine as shown in the illustration.



- We recommend that you save the original packaging.
- If for any reason you must ship your machine, carefully repack the machine in the original packaging to avoid any damage during transit. The machine should be adequately insured with the carrier. For details on how to repack the machine: >> *Advanced User's Guide: Packing and shipping the machine.*
- To ensure safe operation the supplied plug must be inserted only into a standard power outlet that is properly grounded through the standard electrical wiring. Non grounded equipment may cause an electrical shock hazard, and may cause excessive electrical noise radiation.
- The network cable is not a standard accessory. Buy the appropriate interface cable for the connection you want to use.

USB cable

- We recommend using a USB 2.0 cable (Type A/B) that is no longer than 2 metres.
- DO NOT connect the interface cable at this time. Connecting the interface cable is done during the MFL-Pro Suite installation process.

Network cable

Use a straight-through Category 5 (or greater) twisted-pair cable for 10BASE-T or 100BASE-TX Fast Ethernet Network.

2 Remove the packing material from the machine

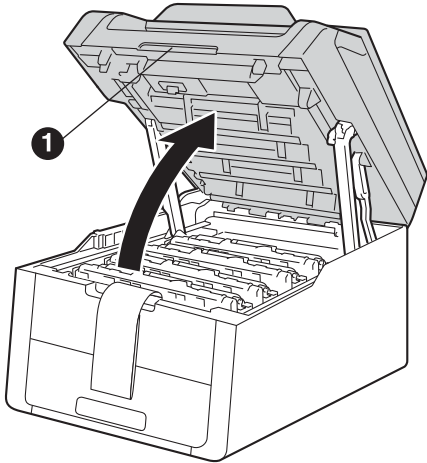

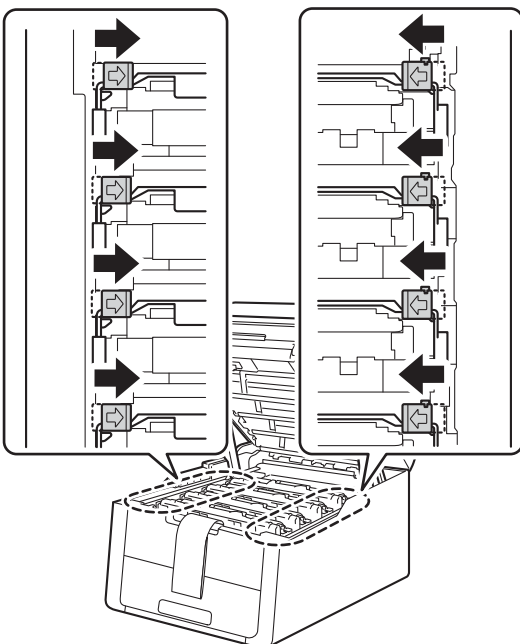

a Remove the packing tape from the outside of the machine, the silica gel pack on the support flap and the film covering the scanner glass.

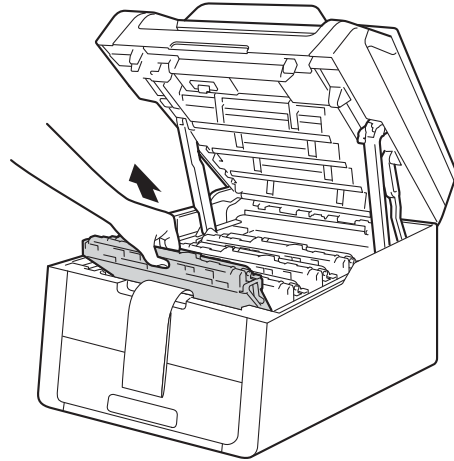
b Fully open the top cover by lifting the handle up **1**.



c Slide all eight yellow drum locks in the direction of the arrows (the locks may require a firm push).

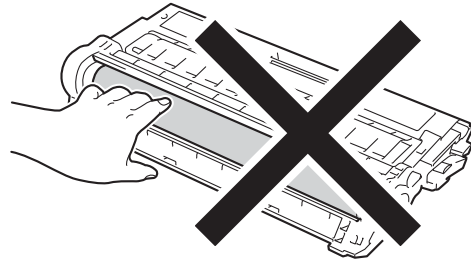


d Take out all four drum and toner cartridge assemblies.

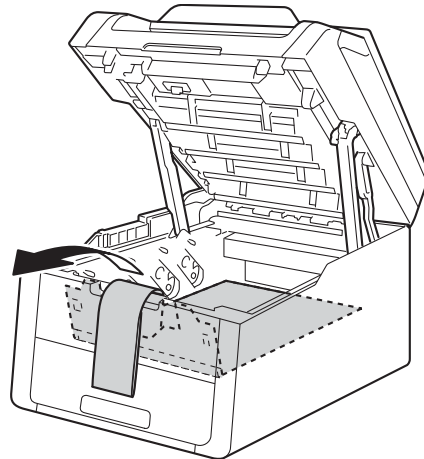

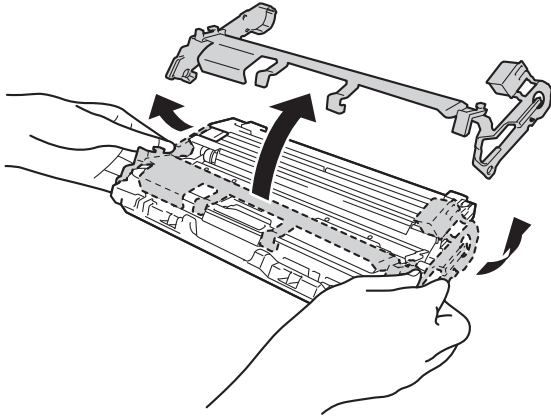

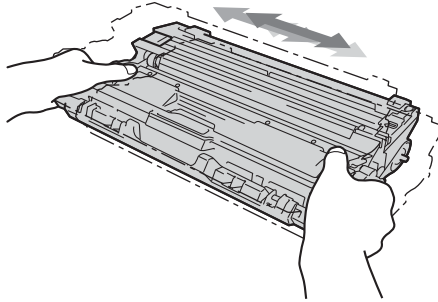
e Remove the orange packing piece from the belt unit.



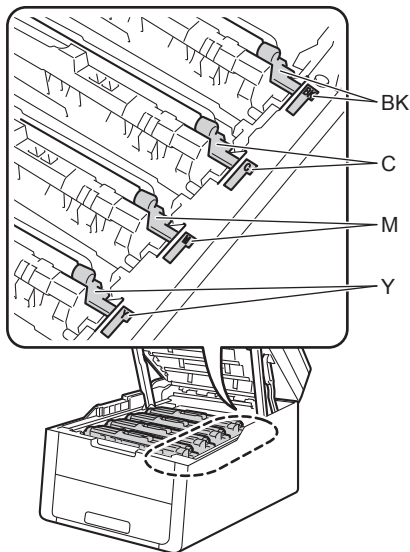
- f** Remove the orange packing piece from each drum and toner cartridge assembly.



- g** Using both hands, hold each drum and toner cartridge assembly level, and gently shake it from side to side several times to distribute the toner evenly inside the assembly.



- h** Slide all four drum and toner cartridge assemblies into the machine. Make sure the toner cartridge colour matches the same colour label on the machine.

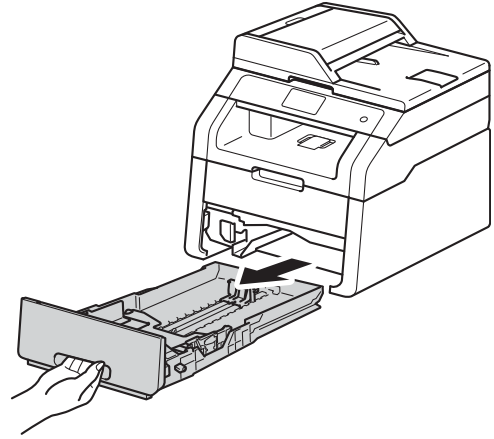

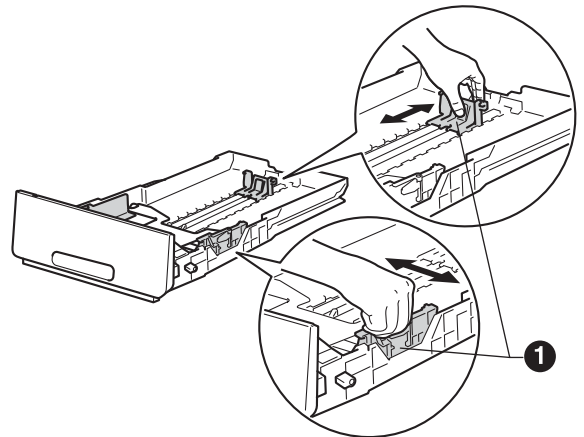
- i** Close the top cover of the machine.

3 Load paper in the paper tray

- a** Pull the paper tray completely out of the machine.

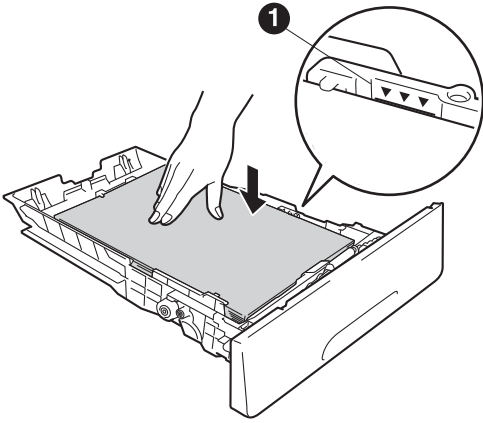


- b** While pressing the green paper-guide release lever ❶, slide the paper guides to fit the paper size you are loading in the tray. Make sure the guides are firmly in the slots.



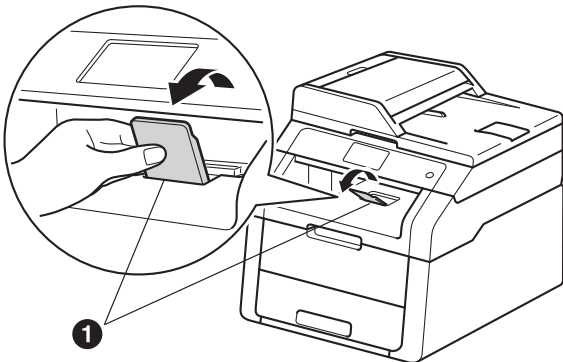
- c** Fan the stack of paper well to avoid paper jams and misfeeds.


- d** Load paper in the tray and make sure:
- The paper is below the maximum paper mark (▼▼▼) ❶. Overfilling the paper tray will cause paper jams.
 - The side to be printed on is face down.
 - The paper guides touch the sides of the paper so it will feed correctly.



- e** Put the paper tray firmly back in the machine. Make sure it is completely inserted into the machine.

- f** Lift the support flap ❶ to prevent paper from sliding off the face-down output tray.

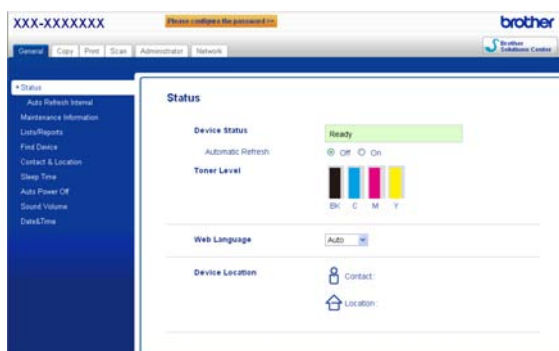
Web Based Management (web browser)

The Brother print server is equipped with a web server that allows you to monitor its status or change some of its configuration settings using HTTP (Hypertext Transfer Protocol).

NOTE

We recommend Windows® Internet Explorer® 8.0/9.0 for Windows® and Safari 5.0 for Macintosh. Please also make sure JavaScript and cookies are always enabled in whichever browser you use. To use a web browser, you will need to know the IP address of the print server, which is listed on the Network Configuration Report.

- a** Open your browser.
- b** Type “http://machine’s IP address/” into your browser’s address bar (where “machine’s IP address” is the IP address of the Brother machine or the print server name).
 - For example: http://192.168.1.2/




NOTE

If you have configured an optional login password, you must enter it when prompted to access the Web Based Management.

Print the Network Configuration Report

You can print the Network Configuration Report to confirm the current network settings.

The machine will print the current network settings.

Restore the network settings to the factory default

You can restore all network settings of the internal Print/Scan server to the factory default.

The machine will restart. Disconnect the cables, and after the machine has restarted, reconnect the cables.

Colour Correction

The output density and print position of each colour may vary depending on the machine's environment. Factors like temperature and humidity can affect colour. Colour calibration and colour registration help you to improve the colour density and the print position of each colour.



Colour Calibration

Calibration helps you to improve the colour density.

NOTE

- If you print using the BR-Script printer driver, you need to perform the calibration from the control panel (see *Using the control panel* >> page 18).
- If you print using the Windows® printer driver, the driver will get the calibration data automatically if both **Use Calibration Data** and **Get Device Data Automatically** are on (>> *Software User's Guide*).
- If you print using the Macintosh printer driver, you need to perform the calibration using **Status Monitor**. After turning **Status Monitor** on, choose **Color Calibration** from **Control** menu (>> *Software User's Guide*).

Auto registration helps you to improve the print position of each colour.
