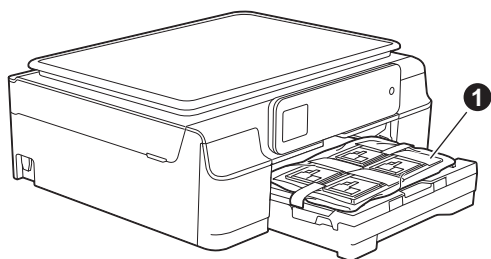
#### USB cable

You need to purchase the correct USB cable.

We recommend using a USB 2.0 cable (Type A/B) that is no more than two metres long.

**a** Remove the protective tape and film covering the machine, and also from the Touchscreen.

**b** Remove the plastic bag ❶ containing the ink cartridges from on top of the paper tray.



**c** Make sure you have all the components.

## 2 Connect the power cord

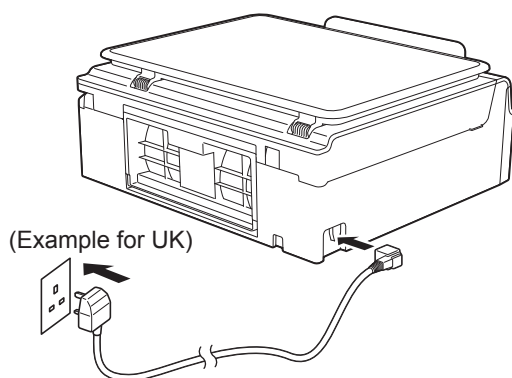
### ⚠ WARNING

The machine must be fitted with an earthed plug.

### NOTE



DO NOT connect the USB cable yet (if you are using a USB cable).

**a** Connect the power cord.



### NOTE

- The Warning LED on the control panel will stay on until you have installed the ink cartridges.
- To prolong the life of the print head, provide the best ink cartridge economy and maintain print quality, we do not recommend unplugging the machine frequently and/or leaving the machine unplugged for extended periods of time. Each time you plug the machine in, it automatically cleans the print head, which uses some of your ink.

We recommend using  to power down the machine. Using  allows minimal power to the machine, resulting in periodic, but less frequent, cleaning of the print head.

## 3 Choose your language

**a** Choose your language.

**b** Press Yes or No.

### NOTE

If you set the wrong language, you can change it after setting the date and time. (►► *Advanced User's Guide: Changing the Touchscreen language*)

## Install the ink cartridges

### CAUTION

If ink gets in your eyes, wash it out with water at once and call a doctor if you are concerned.

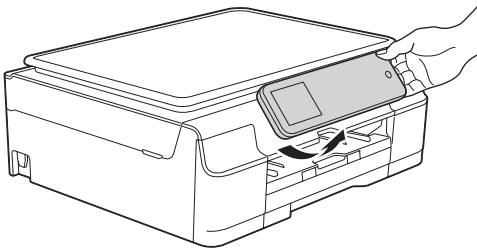
### NOTE

Make sure you install the Introductory Ink Cartridges included with your machine first.

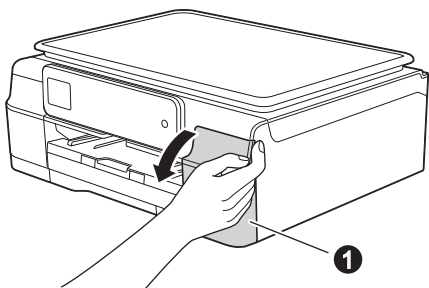
- a** Make sure that the power is turned on. The Touchscreen will show **No Ink Cartridge**.

### NOTE

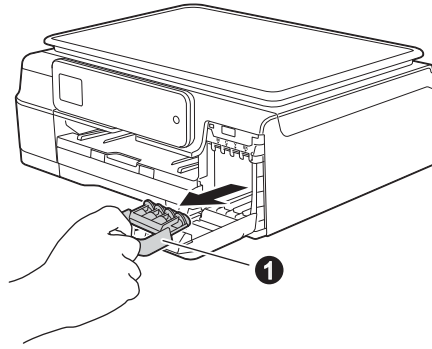
You can adjust the control panel angle to read the Touchscreen more easily. Hold the edge of the control panel to avoid accidentally pressing any of the Touchscreen options.



- b** Open the ink cartridge cover **1**.



- c** Remove the orange protective part **1**.



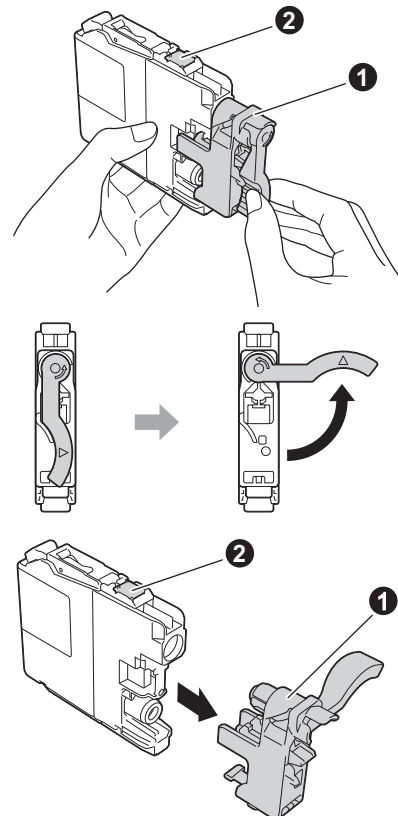
### NOTE

Do not throw away the orange protective part. You will need it if you transport the machine.

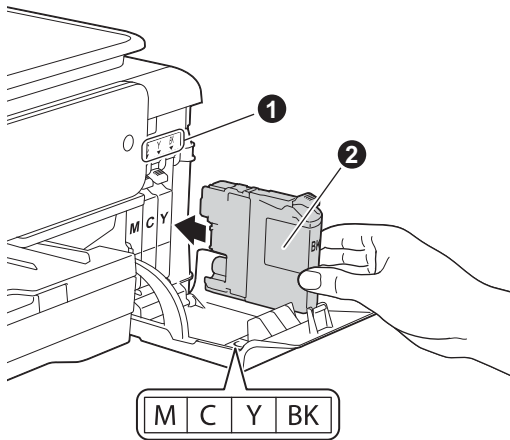
- d** Unpack the ink cartridge. Turn the green release lever on the orange protective packing **1** counterclockwise until it clicks to release the vacuum seal. Then remove the orange protective packing **1** as shown.

### IMPORTANT

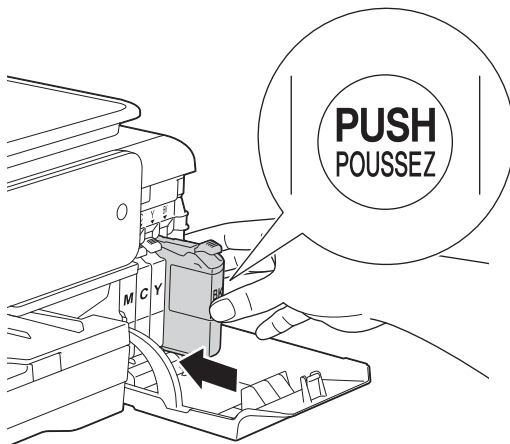
- DO NOT shake the ink cartridges. If ink stains your skin or clothing, wash with soap or detergent at once.
- DO NOT touch the cartridge in the area indicated **2**, as this can cause the machine not to function with the cartridge.



- e** Take care to match the sticker colour ① with the cartridge colour ② as shown in the diagram below. Install each ink cartridge in the direction of the arrow on the label.



- f** Gently push the back of the ink cartridge marked "PUSH" until the cartridge lever lifts. After all the ink cartridges are installed, close the ink cartridge cover.

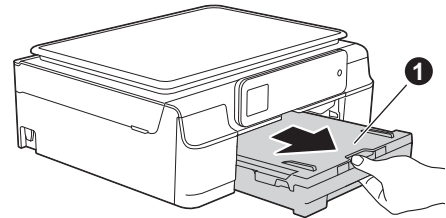


## NOTE

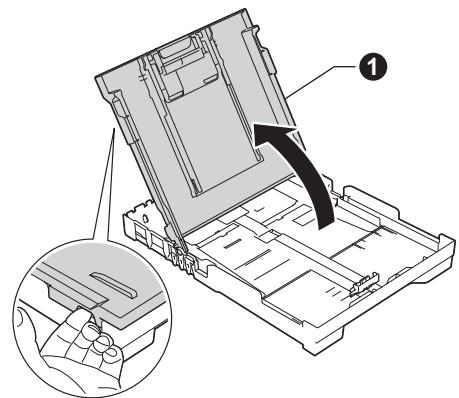
The machine will prepare the ink tube system for printing. This process will take approximately four minutes. Do not turn off the machine. We recommend you perform the next step while waiting.

# 5 Load plain A4 paper

- a** Pull the paper tray ① completely out of the machine.

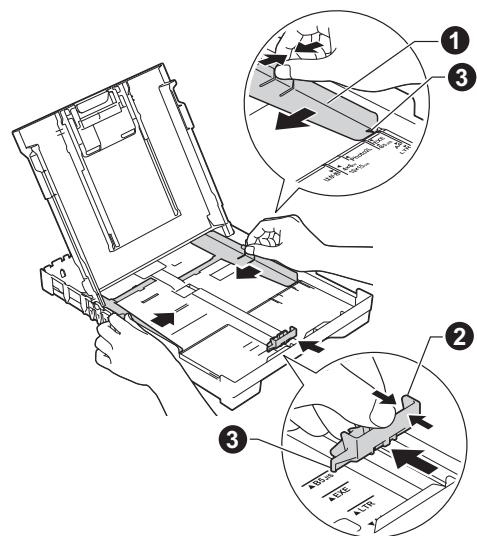


- b** Open the output paper tray cover ①.

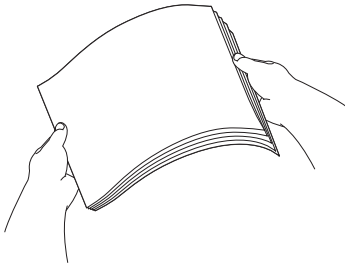


- c** Gently press and slide the paper width guides ① and then the paper length guide ② to fit the paper size.

Make sure that the triangular marks ③ on the paper width guides ① and paper length guide ② line up with the mark for the paper size you are using.



- d** Fan the stack of paper well to avoid paper jams and misfeeds.



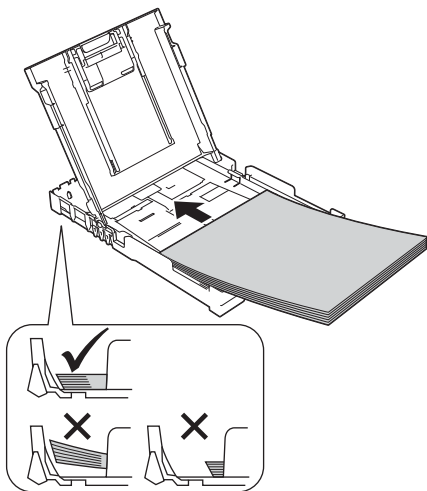
**NOTE**

Always make sure that the paper is not curled or wrinkled.

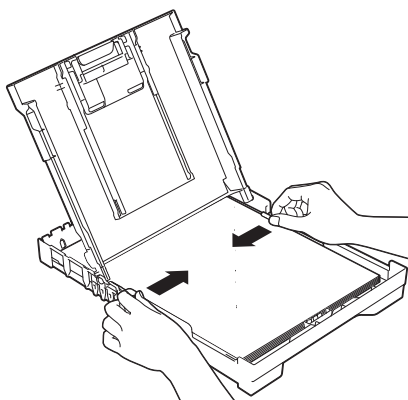
- e** Gently put the paper into the paper tray print side down and top edge first. Check that the paper is flat in the tray.

**IMPORTANT**

Be careful that you do not push the paper in too far; it may lift at the back of the tray and cause paper feed problems.

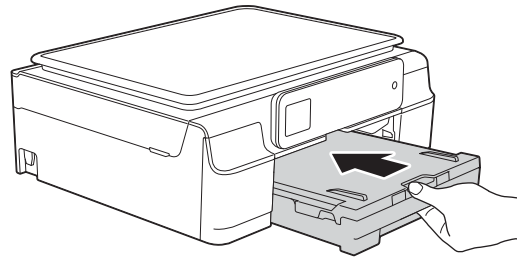


- f** Gently adjust the paper width guides to the paper with both hands. Make sure that the paper width guides touch the edges of the paper.

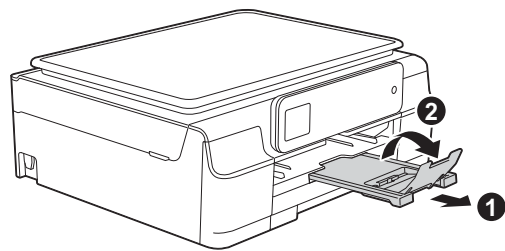


- g** Close the output paper tray cover.

- h** *Slowly* push the paper tray completely into the machine.



- i** While holding the paper tray in place, pull out the paper support **1** until it clicks, and then unfold the paper support flap **2**.



**6 Check the print quality**

- a** When the preparation process has finished, the Touchscreen shows `Load Paper` and `Press Start`.  
Press `Start`.

- b** Check the quality of the four colour blocks on the sheet. (black/yellow/cyan/magenta)

- c** If all lines are clear and visible, press `Yes` to finish the quality check and go to the next step.

If lines are missing, press `No` and follow the steps on the Touchscreen.

## Set the date and time

The Touchscreen displays the date and time. In addition, setting the date and time allows the machine to clean the print head regularly and maintain optimum print quality.

- a** Enter the last two digits of the year on the Touchscreen, and then press **OK**.  
To delete a digit, press  to backspace, and then enter the correct digit.



(e.g. Enter 1 3 for 2013.)

- b** Repeat for month/day/time in 24-hour format.
- c** Press **OK**.

### NOTE

- You can change the date and time if needed. For more information ►► *Basic User's Guide: Setting the date and time*
- If a prompt message appears on the Touchscreen, read it and press **OK** to continue.

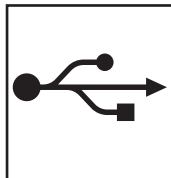
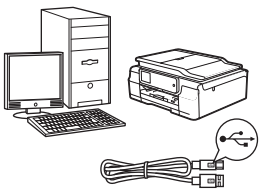

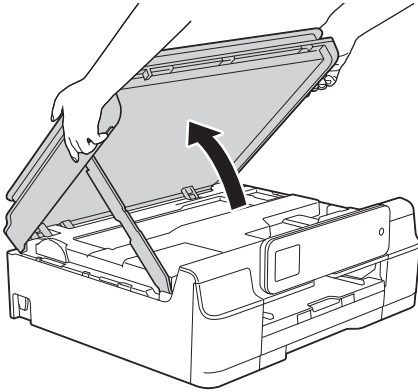





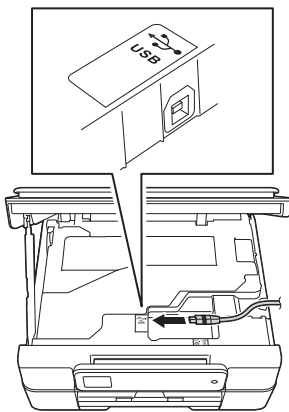


## 11 Connect the USB cable

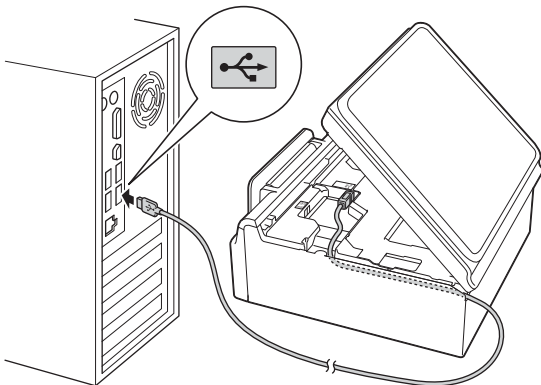
**a** Lift the scanner cover until it locks securely into the open position.



**b** Connect the USB cable to the USB port marked with a  symbol. You will find the USB port inside the machine, as shown in the callout below.



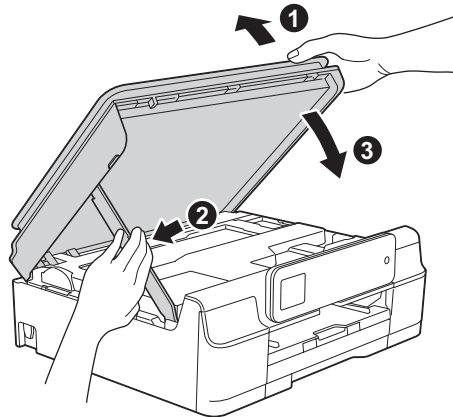
**c** Carefully guide the USB cable into the cable channel and out the back of the machine. Connect the cable to your computer.



### IMPORTANT

Make sure that the cable does not restrict the cover from closing, or an error may occur.

**d** Lift the scanner cover to release the lock **1**. Gently push the scanner cover support down **2** and close the scanner cover **3** using both hands.



### CAUTION

Be careful not to pinch your fingers when the scanner cover closes.

**e** The installation will continue automatically. The installation screens appear one after another.

### NOTE

DO NOT cancel any of the screens during the installation. It may take a few seconds for all screens to appear.

**f** If the **Environmental Advice for Imaging Equipment** screen appears, click **Next**.

**g** When the **On-Line Registration** screen appears, follow the on-screen instructions. Click **Next**.

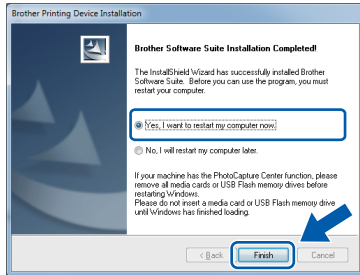
**h** If you do not want to set your machine as the default printer, clear the **Set as Default Printer** check box, and then click **Next**.

**i** When the **Setup is Complete** window appears, confirm the settings, and then click **Next**.



## 12 Finish and restart

- a** Click **Finish** to restart your computer. After restarting the computer, you must log on with Administrator rights.



### NOTE

- If an error message appears during the software installation, do one of the following:
  - Windows® XP, Windows Vista® and Windows® 7 users: Run the **Installation Diagnostics** located in (**Start**) > **All Programs** > **Brother** > **DCP-XXXX** (where XXXX is your model name).

- When the **Software Update Setting** screen appears, choose the software update setting you want and click **OK**.

## For wireless network interface users

### 9 Before you begin

First you must configure the wireless network settings of your machine to communicate with your access point/router. After the machine is configured to communicate with your access point/router, computers on your network will have access to the machine. To use the machine from these computers, you will need to install the drivers and software. The following steps will guide you through the configuration and installation process.

To achieve optimum results with normal everyday document printing, place the Brother machine as close to the network access point/router as possible with minimal obstructions. Large objects and walls between the two devices as well as interference from other electronic devices can affect the data transfer speed of your documents.

Due to these factors, wireless may not be the best method of connection for all types of documents and applications. If you are printing large files, such as multi-page documents with mixed text and large graphics, you may want to consider choosing USB for the fastest throughput speed.

#### NOTE

If you have previously configured the wireless settings of the machine, you must reset the network settings before you can configure the wireless settings again.

On your machine, press  (Settings).

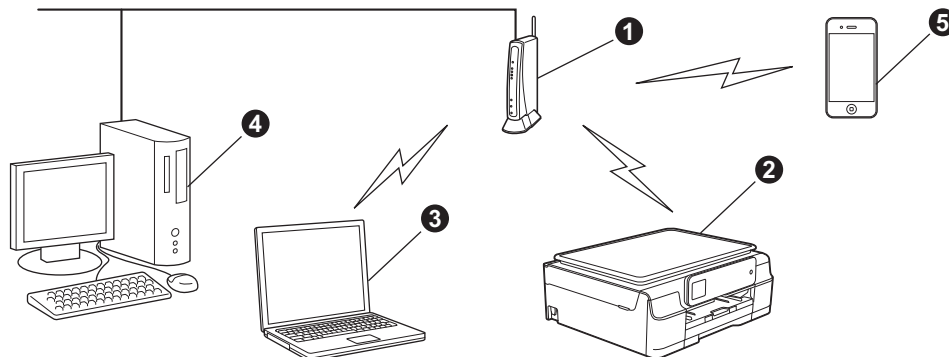
Press **▲** or **▼** to display **Network**. Press **Network**.

Press **▲** or **▼** to display **Network Reset**. Press **Network Reset**.

Press **Yes** to accept. Hold down **Yes** for 2 seconds to confirm.

The following instructions are for infrastructure mode (connected to a computer through an access point/router).

#### Infrastructure Mode



- 1 Access point/router
- 2 Wireless network machine (your machine) connected to the access point/router
- 3 Wireless-capable computer connected to the access point/router
- 4 Wired computer connected to the access point/router
- 5 Mobile device connected to the access point/router

Please make sure the wireless network settings of the machine match the access point/router.

#### NOTE

To set up your machine in Ad-hoc mode (connected to a wireless-capable computer without an access point/router), see instructions in the *Software and Network User's Guide* on the CD-ROM.

## 11 Manual setup from the control panel using the Setup Wizard (Windows®, Macintosh and mobile devices)

**a** Press **WiFi**.  
Press **Setup Wizard**.

When **Enable WLAN?** is displayed, press **Yes** to accept.

This will start the wireless setup wizard.

To cancel, press **No**.

**b** The machine will search for available SSIDs. It will take several seconds to display a list of available SSIDs.

If a list of SSIDs is displayed, press **^** or **v** to choose the SSID you wrote down in step **10-b** on page 16. Select the SSID you want to connect with.

If the wireless access point/router of the selected SSID supports WPS, and the machine asks to use WPS, go to **c**.

If the machine asks you to enter a Network Key, go to **d**.

Otherwise, go to **e**.

### NOTE

- If the list is blank, check that the wireless access point/router has power and is broadcasting the SSID. Move your machine closer to the wireless access point/router and try starting from **a** again.
- If your access point is set to not broadcast the SSID, you will have to manually add the SSID name. For details, see the *Software and Network User's Guide*.

**c** Press **Yes** to connect your machine using WPS. (If you choose **No (Manual)** to continue manual configuration, go to **d** to enter a Network Key.)

When the Touchscreen instructs you to start WPS, press the WPS button on your wireless access point/router, and then press **Next** to proceed.

Go to **e**.

**d** Enter the Network Key you wrote down in step **10-b** on page 16 using the Touchscreen.

### NOTE

The letters appear in this order: lower case and then upper case. Press **AB** to cycle between letters, numbers and special characters. (The characters available may differ depending on your country.) To move the cursor to the right, press **▶**.

(For details, see *Entering Text for Wireless Settings* on page 28.)

Press **OK** when you have entered all the characters, then press **Yes** to apply your settings.

**e** Your machine will now try to connect to your wireless network. It may take a few minutes.

Press **OK**.

### NOTE

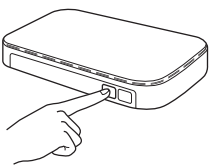

When **Enable WLAN?** is displayed, press **Yes** to accept.
