WARNING

- Plastic bags are used in the packing of your machine. To avoid the danger of suffocation, keep these plastic bags away from babies and children. Plastic bags are not toys.

USB cable

It is recommended to use a USB 2.0 cable (Type A/B) that is no more than 2 metres long.

Network cable

Use a straight-through Category5 (or greater) twisted-pair cable for 10BASE-T or 100BASE-TX Fast Ethernet Network.

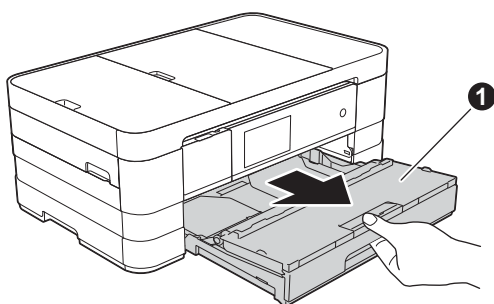

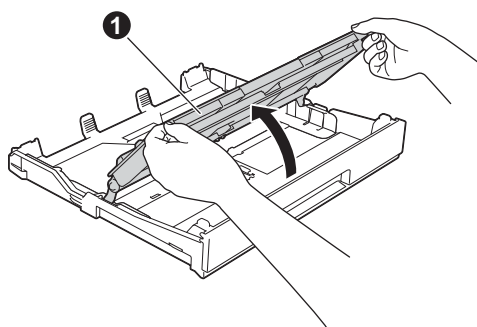
DO NOT carry the machine by holding the scanner cover or the Jam Clear Cover. Doing this may cause the machine to slip out of your hands. Only carry the machine by placing your hands under the entire machine.

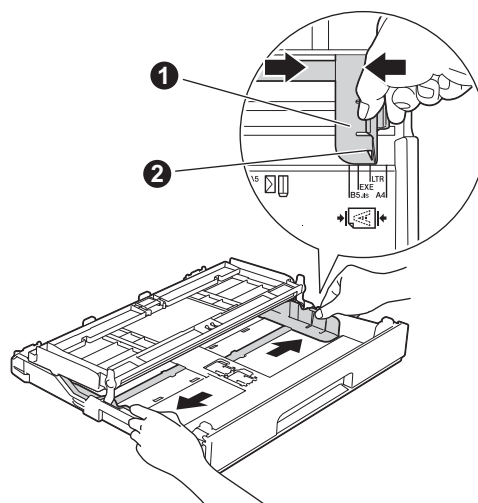
- a** Pull the paper tray ① completely out of the machine.



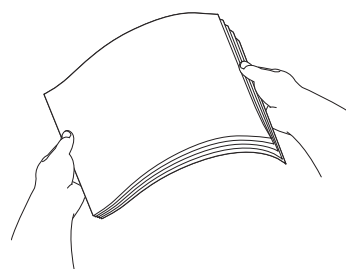
- b** Open the output paper tray cover ①.



- c** Gently press and slide the paper guides ① to fit the paper size. Make sure that the triangular mark ② on the paper guide ① lines up with the mark for the paper size you are using.



- d** Fan the stack of paper well to avoid paper jams and misfeeds.



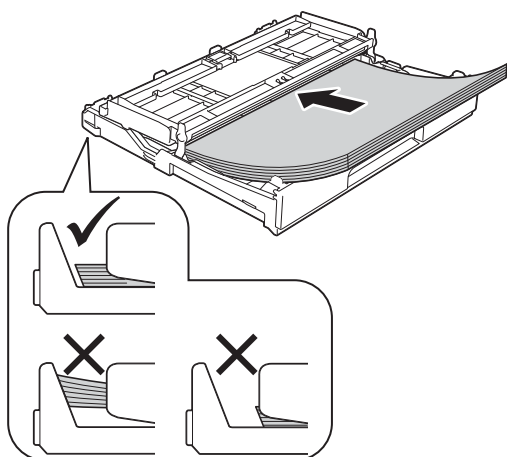

- h** Slowly push the paper tray completely into the machine.



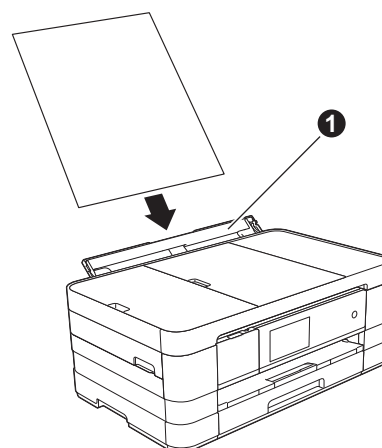
- i** While holding the paper tray in place, pull out the paper support **1** until it clicks, and then unfold the paper support flap **2**.

*For printing and copying on special media, open the manual feed slot **1** on the back of the machine. Feed only one sheet at a time of A3, Ledger, Legal, envelopes, or thicker paper when using the manual feed slot.*

Connect the power cord and telephone line

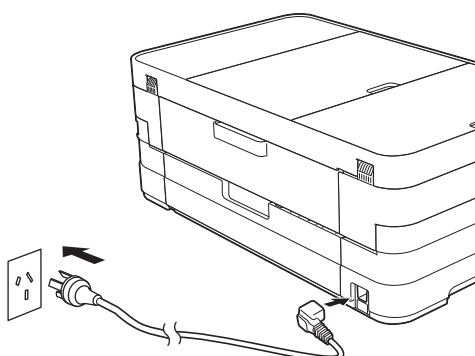
⚠ WARNING

- The machine must be fitted with an earthed plug.
- Since the machine is grounded through the power outlet, you can protect yourself from potentially hazardous electrical conditions on the telephone network by keeping the power cord connected to your machine when you connect it to a telephone line. Similarly, you can protect yourself when you want to move your machine by disconnecting the telephone line first and then the power cord.



IMPORTANT

DO NOT connect the USB cable yet (if you are using a USB cable).

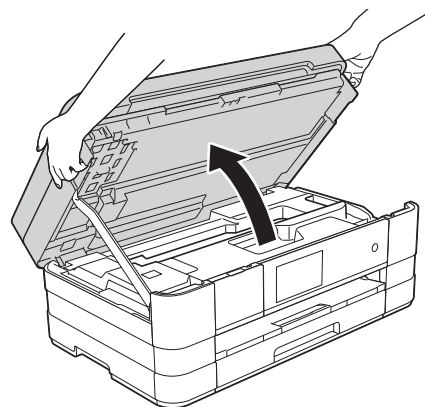

- If you do not plan to use the fax feature on this machine, go to next step.
- To prolong print head life, provide the best ink cartridge economy and maintain print quality, we do not recommend frequently unplugging the machine and/or leaving the machine unplugged for extended periods of time. We recommend using  to power down the machine. Using  allows minimal power to the machine, which ensures periodic cleaning of the print head.

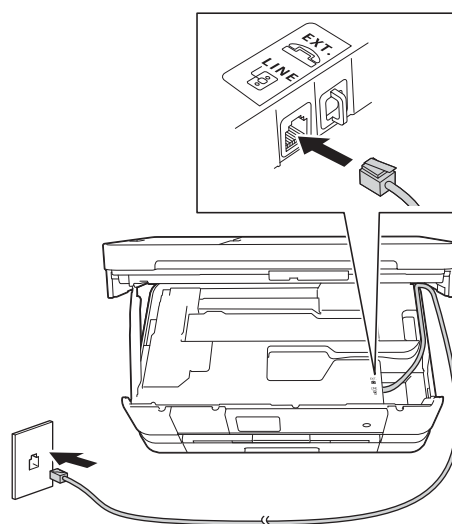

Install the ink cartridges

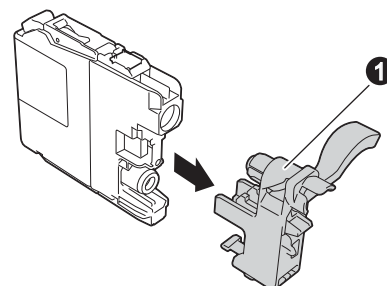
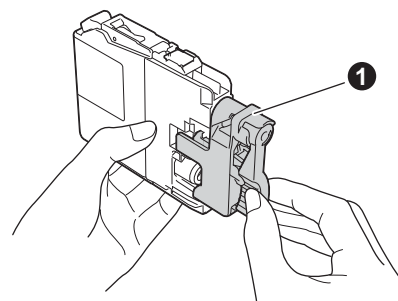
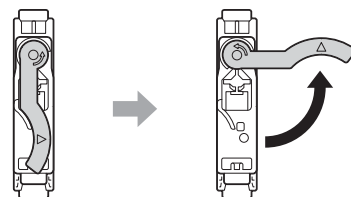
- c** Remove the orange protective part ❶.



NOTE

Do not throw away the orange protective part. You will need it if you transport the machine.

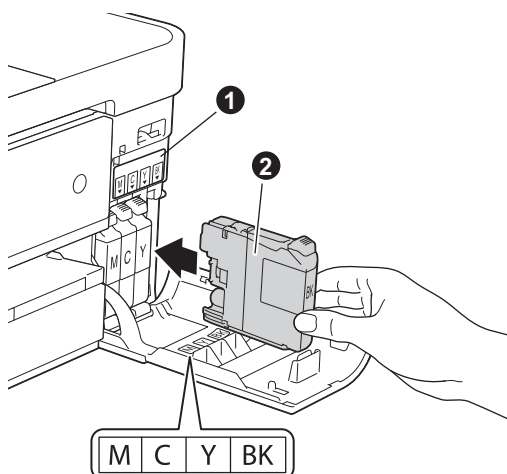
- d** Unpack the ink cartridge. Turn the green release lever on the orange protective packing ❶ counterclockwise until it clicks to release the vacuum seal. Then remove the orange protective packing ❶ as shown.



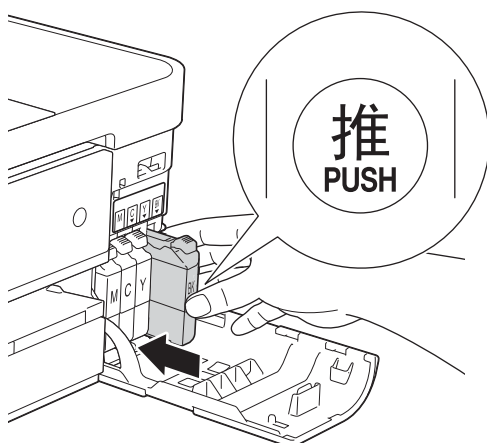
IMPORTANT

DO NOT shake the ink cartridges. If ink stains your skin or clothing, wash with soap or detergent at once.

- e** Take care to match the sticker colour ① with the cartridge colour ② as shown in the diagram below.
Install each ink cartridge in the direction of the arrow on the label.



- f** Gently push the back of the ink cartridge marked "PUSH" until the cartridge lever lifts. After all the ink cartridges are installed close the ink cartridge cover.



IMPORTANT

After initial installation of the ink cartridges, the machine will start cleaning the ink tube system. This cleaning process will last approximately four minutes.

DO NOT unplug the machine from the power outlet or attempt to stop the cleaning process. Interruption of cleaning process may cause undesired print quality problems.

IMPORTANT

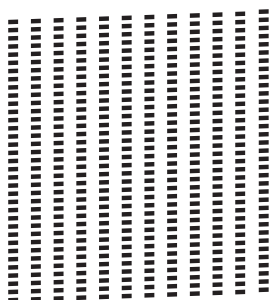
- **DO NOT** take out ink cartridges if you do not need to replace them. If you do so, it may reduce the ink quantity and the machine will not know the quantity of ink left in the cartridge.
- **DO NOT** repeatedly insert and remove the cartridges. If you do so, ink may seep out of the cartridge.
- Once you open an ink cartridge, install it in the machine and use it up within six months of installation. Use unopened ink cartridges by the expiration date written on the cartridge package.
- **DO NOT** dismantle or tamper with the ink cartridge, this can cause the ink to leak out of the cartridge.
- Brother multifunction machines are designed to work with ink of a particular specification and will work to a level of optimum performance when used with genuine Brother branded ink cartridges. Brother cannot guarantee this optimum performance if ink or ink cartridges of other specifications are used. Brother does not therefore recommend the use of cartridges other than genuine Brother branded cartridges with this machine or the refilling of empty cartridges with ink from other sources. If damage is caused to the print head or other parts of this machine as a result of using incompatible products with this machine, any repairs required as a result may not be covered by the warranty.

Before you begin

First you must configure the wireless network settings of your machine to communicate with your access point/router. After the machine is configured to communicate with your access point/router, computers on your network will have access to the machine. To use the machine from these computers, you will need to install the drivers and software. The following steps will guide you through the configuration and installation process.

To achieve optimum results with normal everyday document printing, place the Brother machine as close to the network access point/router as possible with minimal obstructions. Large objects and walls between the two devices as well as interference from other electronic devices can affect the data transfer speed of your documents.

Due to these factors, wireless may not be the best method of connection for all types of documents and applications. If you are printing large files, such as multi-page documents with mixed text and large graphics, you may want to consider choosing wired Ethernet for a faster data transfer or USB for the fastest throughput speed.

Although your Brother machine can be used in both a wired and wireless network, only one of the connection methods can be used at a time.

NOTE

If you have previously configured the wireless settings of the machine you must reset the network settings before you can configure the wireless settings again.
