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
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Introduction

Brother Web Connect

Certain websites provide services that allow users to upload and view images and files on the website. Your Brother machine can scan images and upload them to these services, and also download from and print images that are already uploaded to these services.



1 Photos, images, documents and other files

Accessible services

The following services can be accessed from your Brother machine:

■ Picasa Web Albums™

Picasa Web Albums™ is an online photo sharing service. Images can be uploaded, organized into albums, and shared with other users.

■ Google Drive[™]

Google Drive™ is an online document storage, editing, sharing and file synchronization service.

■ Flickr®

Flickr[®] is an online photo sharing service. Images can be uploaded, organized into albums, and shared with other users.

■ Facebook

Facebook is a social networking service that also allows images to be uploaded and shared with other users.

Conditions for using Brother Web Connect

Service account

In order to use Brother Web Connect, you must have an account with the desired service. If you do not already have an account, use a computer to access the service's website and create an account.

You do not need to create an account if you use Brother CreativeCenter.

Internet connection

In order to use Brother Web Connect, your Brother machine must be connected to a network that has access to the Internet through either a wired or wireless connection. For more information on connecting and configuring your machine, see the Quick Setup Guide included with your machine.

For network setups that use a proxy server, the machine must also be configured to use a proxy server (see *Proxy server settings* on page 4). If you are not sure, check with your network administrator.

NOTE

A proxy server is a computer that serves as an intermediary between computers without a direct Internet connection, and the Internet.

MFL-Pro Suite installation

The initial installation of Brother Web Connect requires a computer that has access to the Internet and has Brother MFL-Pro Suite installed. Follow the steps outlined in the Quick Setup Guide to install MFL-Pro Suite (from the supplied installer CD-ROM) and configure the machine to be able to print over your wired or wireless network.

Proxy server settings

If the network uses a proxy server, the following proxy server information must be configured on the machine. If you are not sure, check with your network administrator.

- Proxy server address
- Port number
- User name
- Password

 Press Network.
- 4 Swipe up or down, or press ▲ or ▼ to display Web Connect Settings.

 Press Web Connect Settings.
- Press Proxy Settings.
- 6 Swipe up or down, or press ▲ or ▼ to display Proxy Connection.

 Press Proxy Connection.
- 7 Press On.
- 8 Press the option that you want to set, and then enter the proxy server information.

- 1 Press (Settings).
- Press All Settings.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to display Network.
 Press Network.
- 4 Press A or V to display Web Connect Settings.

- 6 Press ▲ or ▼ to display Proxy Connection. Press Proxy Connection.
- 7 Press On.
- 8 Press the option that you want to set, and then enter the proxy server information. Press OK.



Step-by-step overview

Configure the settings using the following procedure:

Step 1: Create an account with the desired service (see page 7).


Access the service's website using a computer and create an account. (If you already have an account, there is no need to create an additional account.)





Step 2: Apply for Brother Web Connect access (see page 7).


Start Brother Web Connect access using a computer and obtain a temporary ID.





Step 3: Register (on the machine), the account information that is needed to access the desired services (see page 9).

Enter the temporary ID to enable the service on the machine. Specify the account name as you would like it to be displayed on the machine, and enter a PIN if you would like to use one.







The machine can now use the service.

How to create an account for each of the desired services

In order to use Brother Web Connect to access an online service, you must have an account with that online service. If you do not already have an account, use a computer to access the website of the service and create an account. After creating an account, log on and use the account once with a computer before using the Brother Web Connect feature. Otherwise, you may not be able to access the service using Brother Web Connect.

If you already have an account, there is no need to create an additional account.

Continue with the next procedure, How to apply for Brother Web Connect access on page 7.

NOTE

You do not need to create an account if you will use the service as a guest. You can use only certain services as a guest. If the service you want to use does not have a guest-user option, you must create an account.

How to apply for Brother Web Connect access

In order to use Brother Web Connect to access online services, you must first apply for Brother Web Connect access using a computer that has Brother MFL-Pro Suite installed:

- 1 Turn on your computer.
- Access the Brother Web Connect application web page.
 - Windows[®] XP, Windows Vista[®] and Windows[®] 7

If you have already installed MFL-Pro Suite, choose (Start) / All Programs / Brother / MFC-XXXX (where XXXX is your model name) / Brother Web Connect.

■ Windows[®] 8

Click (Brother Utilities), and then click the drop-down list and select your model name (if not already selected). Click Use More in the left navigation bar, and then click Brother Web Connect.

NOTE

You can also access the page directly by typing "http://bwc.brother.com" into your web browser's address bar.

■ Macintosh

If you have already installed MFL-Pro Suite, click **Go** from the **Finder** bar / **Applications** / **Brother** / **Utilities** / **Brother Web Connect**.


NOTE

You can also access the page directly in the following ways:

- From the supplied CD-ROM
 - 1 Put the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive. When it launches, double-click the **Brother Support** icon.
 - 2 Click Brother Web Connect.
- · From your web browser

Type "http://bwc.brother.com" into your web browser's address bar.

3 Choose the service you want to use.



4 Follow the on-screen instructions and apply for access.
When finished, your temporary ID will be displayed. Make a note of this temporary ID, as you will need it to register accounts to the machine. The temporary ID is valid for 24 hours.



5 Close the web browser.
Continue with the next procedure, *How to register and delete accounts on the machine* on page 9.

How to register and delete accounts on the machine

Enter the account information and configure your machine so that it can access the service.

You can register up to 10 accounts on your machine.

Register an account

For MFC-J6920DW/J6925DW

- 1 Before you register an account, confirm that the correct date and time are set on the machine's control panel. For more information on setting the date and time, see the Quick Setup Guide included with your machine.
- Swipe left or right, or press or to display the More screen.
- 3 Press Web.
 Information regarding the Internet connection is displayed on the machine's LCD. Read the information and press OK.
- 4 You will be asked if you want to display this information again in the future. Press Yes or No.

NOTE

Occasionally, updates or announcements about your machine's feature will be displayed on the LCD. Read the information, and then press OK.

5 Swipe left or right, or press ◀ or ▶ to display the service with which you want to register. Press the service name.

- 6 If information regarding Brother Web Connect is displayed, press OK.
- 7 Press Register/Delete Account.
- 8 Press Register Account.
- 9 The machine will prompt you to enter the temporary ID you received when you applied for Brother Web Connect access.

Press OK.

10 Enter the temporary ID using the LCD. Press OK.

NOTE

An error message will appear on the LCD if the information you entered does not match the temporary ID you received when you applied for access, or if the temporary ID has expired. Either enter the temporary ID correctly, or apply for access again to receive a new temporary ID (see *How to apply for Brother Web Connect access* on page 7).

- 11 The machine will prompt you to enter the account name that you want to be displayed on the LCD. Press OK.
- 12 Enter the name using the LCD. Press OK.
- 13 Do one of the following:
 - To set a PIN for the account, press Yes. (A PIN prevents unauthorized access to the account.) Enter a four-digit number and press OK.
 - If you do not want to set a PIN, press No.
- When the account information you entered is displayed, confirm that it is correct.
 - Press Yes to register your information as entered.
 - Press No to change any of the information you entered. Go back to step •
- 15 Account registration is complete. Press OK.
- 16 Press 🔼.

For MFC-J3520/J3720/J6520DW/J6720DW

- 1 Before you register an account, confirm that the correct date and time are set on the machine's control panel. For more information on setting the date and time, see the Quick Setup Guide included with your machine.
- Press ◀ or ▶ to display Web. Press Web.
- 3 Information regarding the Internet connection is displayed on the machine's LCD. Read the information and press OK.

You will be asked if you want to display this information again in the future. Press Yes or No.

- Press ▲ or ▼ to display the service with which you want to register. Press the service name.
- 6 If information regarding Brother Web Connect is displayed, press OK.

- The machine will prompt you to enter the temporary ID you received when you applied for Brother Web Connect access.
 Press OK.
- Enter the temporary ID using the LCD. Press OK.

NOTE

An error message will appear on the LCD if the information you entered does not match the temporary ID you received when you applied for access, or if the temporary ID has expired. Either enter the temporary ID correctly, or apply for access again to receive a new temporary ID (see *How to apply for Brother Web Connect access* on page 7).

- 11 The machine will prompt you to enter the account name that you want to be displayed on the LCD.

 Press OK.
- 12 Enter the name using the LCD. Press OK.

- 16 Press [].

Delete an account

For MFC-J6920DW/J6925DW

- Swipe left or right, or press or to display the More screen.
- Press Web.
 If information regarding the Internet connection is displayed on the machine's LCD, read the information and press OK.
- 3 You will be asked if you want to display this information again in the future. Press Yes or No.

NOTE

Occasionally, updates or announcements about your machine's feature will be displayed on the LCD. Read the information, and then press OK.

- 4 Swipe left or right, or press ◀ or ▶ to display the service that hosts the account you want to delete. Press the service name.
- 5 Press Register/Delete Account.
- 6 Press Delete Account.
- 7 Press the account that you want to delete. You can delete more than one account at one time, if needed. The selected account(s) will be indicated by check marks.
- 8 Press OK.
- You will be asked to confirm your selections. Press Yes to delete.
- 10 Account deletion is complete. Press OK.
- 11 Press 🚮.

For MFC-J3520/J3720/J6520DW/J6720DW

- 1 Press ◀ or ▶ to display Web. Press Web.
- 2 If information regarding the Internet connection is displayed on the machine's LCD, read the information and press OK.
- 3 You will be asked if you want to display this information again in the future. Press Yes or No.

NOTE

- 4 Press ▲ or ▼ to display the service that hosts the account you want to delete. Press the service name.
- 5 Press Register/Delete.
- 6 Press Delete Account.
- Press the account that you want to delete. You can delete more than one account at one time, if needed. The selected account(s) will be indicated by check marks.
- 8 Press OK.
- You will be asked to confirm your selections. Press Yes to delete.
- 10 Account deletion is complete.

Setting up Brother Web Connect for Brother CreativeCenter

Brother Web Connect is set up to work with Brother CreativeCenter automatically. No configuration is needed to create calendars, business cards, posters and greeting cards available at http://www.brother.com/creativecenter/.

Scan and Upload

Scanning and uploading documents

Your scanned photos and documents can be uploaded directly to a service without using a computer.

When scanning and uploading JPEG or Microsoft® Office files, black and white scanning is not available.

When scanning and uploading JPEG files, each page is uploaded as a separate file.

Uploaded documents are saved in an album named "From BrotherDevice".

For information regarding restrictions, such as the size or number of documents that can be uploaded, refer to the respective service's website.

For more information about services and supported features, see Accessible services on page 2.

For MFC-J6920DW/J6925DW

- 1 Load your document.
- Swipe left or right, or press ✓ or ► to display the More screen.
- 3 Press web.
 If information regarding the Internet connection is displayed on the machine's LCD, read the information and press ○K.
- 4 You will be asked if you want to display this information again in the future. Press Yes or No.

NOTE

- 5 Swipe left or right, or press ◀ or ▶ to display the service that hosts the account to which you want to upload.
 - Press the service name.
- 6 Swipe up or down, or press ▲ or ▼ to display your account name, and press it.
- 1 If the PIN entry screen is displayed, enter the four-digit PIN and press OK.
- 8 Press Upload from Scanner.
- 9 If you are prompted to specify your document's file format, select the file format of the document you are scanning.
- 10 When the Scan Settings screen appears on the LCD, do one of the following:
 - To change scan settings, see *How to change scan settings* on page 16. After changing the scan settings, go to step **1**.
 - To continue without changing the scan settings, press OK.

- 11 If the LCD prompts you to Select a Tag, press the tag you want.
- 12 Press OK.

If you placed the document in the automatic document feeder (ADF), the machine scans the document and starts uploading.

If you are using the scanner glass, go to step **(B)**.

- When Next Page? is displayed, do one of the following:
 - If there are no more pages to scan, press No. Go to step **6**.
 - To scan more pages, press Yes and go to step ...
- Place the next page on the scanner glass.

Press OK.

The machine starts scanning the page. Repeat steps (a) and (b) for each additional page.

15 The machine uploads the documents.

Press .

For MFC-J3520/J3720/J6520DW/J6720DW

- 1 Load your document.
- Press ◀ or ▶ to display Web. Press Web.
- If information regarding the Internet connection is displayed on the machine's LCD, read the information and press OK.
- 4 You will be asked if you want to display this information again in the future. Press Yes or No.

NOTE

- 5 Press ▲ or ▼ to display the service that hosts the account to which you want to upload. Press the service name.
- 6 Press ▲ or ▼ to display your account name, and then press it.
- 1 If the PIN entry screen is displayed, enter the four-digit PIN and press OK.
- 8 Press Upload: Scanner.
- 9 If you are prompted to specify your document's file format, select the file format of the document you are scanning.
- 10 When the Scan Settings screen appears on the LCD, do one of the following:
 - To change scan settings, see *How to change scan settings* on page 16. After changing the scan settings, go to step ①.

- To continue without changing the scan settings, press OK.
- 11 If the LCD prompts you to Select a Tag, press the tag you want.
- 12 Press OK.

If you placed the document in the automatic document feeder (ADF), the machine scans the document and starts uploading.

If you are using the scanner glass, go to step (3).

- (3) When Next Page? is displayed, do one of the following:
 - If there are no more pages to scan, press No. Go to step **6**.
 - To scan more pages, press Yes and go to step 4.
- Place the next page on the scanner glass.

Press OK.

The machine starts scanning the page. Repeat steps (a) and (b) for each additional page.

15 The machine uploads the documents.

Press .

How to change scan settings

The Scan Settings screen is displayed before you scan the documents that you want to upload (see step **1** on page 14, step **1** on page 15). Swipe up or down, or use the **1** and **1** buttons to scroll through the settings list.

For MFC-J6920DW/J6925DW

Scan Type

- 1 Press Scan Type.
- 2 Choose Color or B&W.
- If you do not want to change any other settings, press OK.

NOTE

- $\bullet \ \ \text{When scanning and uploading JPEG or Microsoft}^{\textcircled{\tiny{\$}}} \ \ \text{Office files, black and white scanning is not available.}$
- When scanning and uploading JPEG files, each page is uploaded as a separate file.

Resolution

- 1 Press Resolution.
- 2 Choose 100 dpi, 200 dpi, 300 dpi, or 600 dpi.

3 If you do not want to change any other settings, press OK.

NOTE

You cannot choose Resolution for Microsoft® Office files.

Scan Size

- 1 Press Scan Size.
- Choose the size you want.
- 3 If you do not want to change any other settings, press OK.

2-sided Scan (For MFC-J6920DW/J6925DW)

- 1 Press 2-sided Scan.
- 2 Choose LongEdge, ShortEdge, or Off.
- 3 If you do not want to change any other settings, press OK.

NOTE

2-sided Scan is available only when you scan from the ADF. The default setting of 2-sided Scan is "Off".

For MFC-J3520/J3720/J6520DW/J6720DW

Scan Type

- 1 Press Scan Type.
- 2 Choose Color or B&W.
- 3 If you do not want to change any other settings, press OK.

NOTE

- When scanning and uploading JPEG or Microsoft® Office files, black and white scanning is not available.
- When scanning and uploading JPEG files, each page is uploaded as a separate file.

Resolution

- 1 Press Resolution.
- 2 Choose 100 dpi, 200 dpi, 300 dpi, or 600 dpi.
- 3 If you do not want to change any other settings, press OK.

NOTE

You cannot choose ${\tt Resolution}$ for ${\tt Microsoft}^{\circledR}$ Office files.

Scan Size

- 1 Press Scan Size.
- 2 Choose the size you want.
- 3 If you do not want to change any other settings, press OK.

Uploading a document from an external memory device

Documents saved on media such as a memory card or a USB flash drive connected to the machine can be uploaded directly to a service.

Uploaded documents are saved in an album named "From BrotherDevice".

For information regarding restrictions, such as the size or number of documents that can be uploaded, refer to the respective service's website.

For more information about services and supported features, see Accessible services on page 2.

For MFC-J6920DW/J6925DW

- 1) Open the media slot cover.
- Insert a memory card or USB flash drive into your machine. The LCD screen automatically changes.
- Press Web. If information regarding the Internet connection is displayed on the machine's LCD, read the information and press OK.
- You will be asked if you want to display this information again in the future. Press Yes or No.

NOTE

- Swipe left or right, or press ◀ or ▶ to display the service that hosts the account to which you want to upload. Press the service name.
- 6 Swipe up or down, or press ▲ or ▼ to display your account name, and press it.
- If the PIN entry screen is displayed, enter the four-digit PIN and press OK.
- Press Upload from Media.
- Swipe left or right, or press ◀ or ▶ to display the desired document, and press it. Confirm the document on the LCD and press OK. Repeat this step until you have chosen all the documents that you want to upload.
- 10 After you have chosen all of the documents, press OK.

- 11 Press OK.

 The machine starts uploading the document(s).
- 12 Press ...

For MFC-J3520/J3720/J6520DW/J6720DW

- 1 Open the media slot cover.

Download, Print, and Save

Downloading and printing documents

Documents that have been uploaded to your account on a service can be downloaded directly to your machine and printed. Documents that other users have uploaded to their own accounts for sharing can also be downloaded to your machine and printed, as long as you have viewing privileges for those documents.

Certain services allow guest users to view documents that are public. When accessing a service or an account as a guest user, you can view documents that the owner has made public, that is, documents that have no viewing restrictions.

In order to download other users' documents, you must have access privileges to view the corresponding albums or documents.

For Picasa Web Albums™, Flickr[®], Facebook, Google Drive™, Evernote[®], Dropbox, OneDrive and Box

For MFC-J6920DW/J6925DW

- 1 Swipe left or right, or press ◀ or ▶ to display the More screen.
- 2 Press Web.
 If information regarding the Internet connection is displayed on the machine's LCD, read the information and press OK.
- 3 You will be asked if you want to display this information again in the future. Press Yes or No.

NOTE

- Swipe left or right, or press or to display the service that hosts the document you want to download and print.
 - Press the service name.
- Do one of the following:
 - To log on to the service with your account, swipe up or down, or press \(\Delta \) or \(\T \) to display your account name, and press it. Go to step \(\Delta \).

- To access the service as a guest user, swipe down or press ▼ to display

 Use Service as a Guest User, and press it. When the information regarding access as a guest

 user is displayed, press OK. Go to step ⑦.
- 6 If the PIN entry screen is displayed, enter the four-digit PIN and press OK.
- Press Download to Print.
 Do one of the following:
 - If you logged on to the service with your account, go to step 3.
 - If you accessed the service as a guest user, go to step ⑨.
- 8 Do one of the following: (For Picasa Web Albums[™], Flickr[®] and Facebook)
 - To download your own documents from the service, press Your album. Go to step 10.
 - To download other users' documents from the service, press Other user's album. Go to step ②.

(For Google Drive™, Dropbox, Evernote®, OneDrive and Box)

- Go to step **①**.
- 9 Using the LCD, type the account name of the user whose documents you want to download. Press OK.

NOTE

Depending on the service, you may have to select the account name from a list.

- Swipe up or down, or press ▲ or ▼ to display the desired album ¹, and press it.

 Some services do not require documents to be saved in albums. For documents not saved in albums, select Show Unsorted Photos to select documents. Other users' documents cannot be downloaded if they are not saved in an album.
 - An album is a collection of images. However, the actual term may differ depending on the service you use. When using Evernote[®], you must select the notebook, and then select the note.
- Press the thumbnail of the document you want to print.

 Confirm the document on the LCD and press OK.

 Select additional documents to print (you can select up to 10 documents).
- 12 After you have chosen all of the desired documents, press OK.
- 13 The Print Settings screen will be displayed. Do one of the following:
 - To change print settings, see *How to change print settings* on page 27. After changing the print settings, go to step .
 - If you do not want to change print settings, press OK.
- Press OK to print.

 The machine starts downloading and printing the documents.
- 15 Press .

NOTE

When downloading and printing JPEG files, you cannot print from Tray2.

For MFC-J3520/J3720/J6520DW/J6720DW

- 1 Press ◀ or ▶ to display Web.
 Press Web.
- 2 If information regarding the Internet connection is displayed on the machine's LCD, read the information and press OK.
- 3 You will be asked if you want to display this information again in the future. Press Yes or No.

NOTE

Occasionally, updates or announcements about your machine's feature will be displayed on the LCD. Read the information, and then press OK.


Outline, Scan, and Copy or Cut

Scanning, copying, and cutting parts of your documents

When you outline specific areas of a document using a red pen and then scan the document, the outlined areas will be captured and can be processed as images in various ways.


Outline and Scan

When you use a red pen to outline sections of a document and then scan the document, the outlined areas are extracted and saved to media or a cloud service as separate JPEG files.




Copy Outlined Area

When you use a red pen to outline sections of a document and then scan the document, the outlined areas are extracted and printed together.




Cut Outlined Area

When you use a red pen to outline sections of a document and then scan the document, the outlined areas are deleted and the remaining information is printed.



Outlining



- Use a red pen or marker with a tip width of 0.04-0.39 in. (1.0-10.0 mm), that is, from an extra-fine tip up to an extra-thick marker tip.
- Outlined areas with thick red lines are easier to recognize. However, do not use a pen or marker with a tip wider than indicated above.
- The red outline must not be broken and the line must not cross more than once.
- The outlined area must have a length and width of at least 0.4 in. (1 cm).
- If the paper has a dark background color, the outlined area may be difficult to recognize.

The areas outlined using a red pen are deleted from the scanned images.
