### **INTRODUCTION**

Thank you for choosing the PT-1230PC. Your new P-touch labeller uses P-touch Editor Lite software, which is already installed on your labeller. There is no need to install any software or drivers onto your PC in order to make creative labels. This manual includes important precautionary information and simple instructions for operating your new P-touch labeller. Be sure to read the instructions before use and use the product in accordance with these instructions. Keep this manual handy for future reference. If new versions of the PT-1230PC software become available, this manual may not reflect the updated features. Therefore, you may find that the software and the contents in this guide are different.

### SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

### **A** WARNING

- Always use the specified voltage and the suggested AC adapter (AD-24ES) for this machine to prevent any damage or failure • Unplug the power cord immediately and stop using the P-touch labeller during an electrical storm. There may be a remote risk of electric shock from lightning
- · Do not use the AC adapter in places of high humidity such as bathrooms Do not overload the power cord.
- Do not place heavy objects on, or damage the power cord or plug. Do not forcibly bend or pull the power cord. When disconnecting the power cord from the power outlet, al ways hold the plug.
- To prevent fire or electric shock, make sure that the plug is fully inserted in the power outlet. Do not use an outlet that is loose
- Do not get the machine/AC adapter/power plug wet, such as by handling them with wet hands or spilling beverages onto them.
- · Do not disassemble or modify the P-touch labeller/AC adapter/batteries Do not use metallic articles, such as tweezers or a metallic pen, when exchanging the batteries
- Do not throw into fire or heat up the battery.
- · Disconnect the AC adapter, remove batteries and stop using immediately if you notice any abnormal odour, heat, discolouration, deformation or anything unusual while in use or in storage

### **A** CAUTION

- To avoid injuries, do not touch the blade of the cutter unit or any metal parts near the print head
- Do not apply excessive pressure to the cutter lever.
- Remove the batteries and disconnect the AC adapter if you do not intend to use the P-touch labeller for an extended period of time
- Do not use old and new batteries together or mix alkaline batteries with other type batteries, or set the positive and negative end in the wrong position. Otherwise, the batter ies may leak or be damaged.
- To prevent damage or breakage, do not drop or hit the P-touch labeller/AC adapter
- · Use only the USB cable included with the P-touch labeller

#### General Precautions

• Depending on the location, material, and environmental conditions, a label may unpeel or become irremovable, the colour of a label jects. Before applying labels, check the environmental condition and the surface material

- Do not use the P-touch labeller in any way or for any purpose not described in this guide. Doing so may result in accidents or damage to the machine
- Use only Brother TZ tapes with this machine. Do not use tapes that do not have the III mark.
- Do not clean the P-touch labeller with alcohol or other organic solvents. Only use a soft, dry cloth • Do not touch the print head with your fingers at any time, to prevent the possibility of burns. Use a soft wipe (e.g. a cotton swab) when cleaning the print head.
- · Do not put any foreign objects into the tape exit slot or AC adapter connector, etc
- Do not place the P-touch labeller/battery in direct sunlight or rain, near heaters or other hot appliances, in any location exposed to extremely high or low temperatures (e.g. on
- the dashboard or in the back of your car), high humidity, or dusty locations.
- Do not try to print labels using an empty tape cassette in the P-touch labeller. Doing so will damage the print head.
  Do not pull the tape being fed from the P-touch labeller, otherwise the tape cassette or P-touch labeller may be damaged.

## Getting Ready



Connect the P-touch labeller's power supply.

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Insert six new AAA alkaline batteries (LR03). making sure that their poles point in the correct directions. Always replace all six batteries at the same time using brand new



When using the AC adapter (AD-24ES), insert the plug on the adapter cord into the adapter socket on the bottom end of the P-touch labeller. Insert the plug into the nearest standard electrical outlet.

When the P-touch labeller is operating on battery power only, it will turn off automatically if not used for a period of 20 minutes. The message "Unsafe Removal of Device" may be displayed depending on the Operating System running on your PC. Any data being displayed will be saved. When you turn the labeller back on, click on the Editor Lite icon to resume creating your label.

E Zi	This label view is displayed when the software is started. The width of tape currently set is displayed on the left of the label image. When "Auto" is shown on the right, the length of tape is automatically ad- justed to the length of text.	Auto	Inserted text boxes, images, and frames are treated as objects. Objects are surrounded by handles (indicated by eight blue points). These handles will appear when text boxes, images and frames are in- serted.
EE	You can drag the label border to manually change the length and width of the label. Move the pointer to the label area's border. When the blue line appears, drag to the desired length or width.	Auto	Indicates that an object is selected.
J <sup>N</sup>	You can adjust the size of the P-touch Editor Lite window. 12 mm	Guidelines are sometimes displayed when moving objects. They are shown when the object is aligned at the left, right, top, or bottom edge of the printable area, or in the centre. In the illustration to the left, the guidelines indicate that the object is centred at the top edge of the tape.		You can move objects by dragging when the pointer is a crosshair. For text objects, the pointer only changes to a crosshair over the border of the object.

Click in the destination Copy area and select Paste Paste Set the length of blank space on both sides of the label (large or small). Margins Click Insert. Select Text box to insert text onto the label Select From File to insert an image stored on your PC. Insert Select Screen Capture to insert the selected area of the PC screen. Select Symbol to insert one of your PC's built-in symbols. Select Frame to insert one of P-touch Editor Lite built-in frames. Direction Select the object text and click either Horizontal Text or Vertical Text to change the direction of the label. Select a number or character within your text and click **Numbering** to consecutively advance the number on Numbering each label. Click - to the right of the Print button and click Print Options. Check the Numbering box and enter the number of labels being printing in the Count field. Click the Print button Change Image Select the image and click Change Image to replace the current image with a different image. Rotate Rotate objects to 0°, 90°, 180° or 270°. Select one of the objects and click Order, then select Bring to Front, Send to Back, Bring Forward, or Order Send Backward to set the order of each object in the layer. Click Options Select either mm (mm) or inches (in) to set the measurement unit setting. Options Select P-touch Editor Lite language. Restart the application to apply the new selected "Language". Select either Display New Value after Printing or Reset to Original Value after Printing to set the numbering option. The LED is flashing.	This is an error message. Please press the Power/feed button to clear the error message. If the LED remains flashing after performing the above, please contact Broth- er Customer Service for further assistance.
I cannot turn the P-touch labeller on.	Check to see that the batteries are installed correctly, or that the recommend- ed power adapter is securely connected.
I cannot exit P-touch Editor Lite.	Check if an error message is being displayed, if so try to rectify the problem. Please note that you cannot exit P-touch Editor Lite while labels are being printed.
A blank horizontal line appears through the printed label.	
The label is difficult to cut.	Clean the cutter blade using a cotton swab moistened with alcohol. * Do not touch the cutter blade directry with your fingers.
