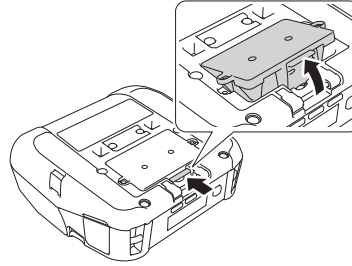
Important

- The Battery Eliminator Kit must be securely installed and NEVER installed where it may come in close contact with the vehicle operator or passenger.
 - DO NOT use the printer while driving, otherwise this may result in property damage or personal injury.
 - Ensure the power cables are correctly connected before applying power. Incorrectly connected power cables can cause serious injuries and damages.

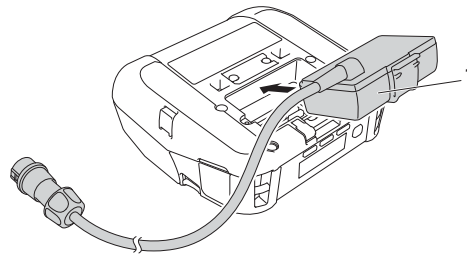

Install the Dummy Battery Pack

- 1 Unlock and pull out the printer's battery cover.



- 2 Insert the Dummy Battery Pack assembly until it locks into place.



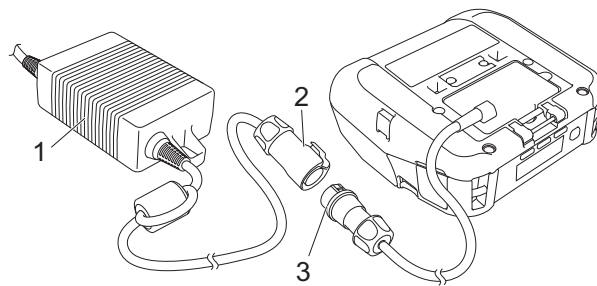
1 Dummy Battery Pack



Note

DO NOT lose the battery cover as you will need to reattach it later.

- 3 Connect the Joint Cable of the Power Adapter (2) and the Power Cable of the Dummy Battery Pack (3) until they lock into place.

Note

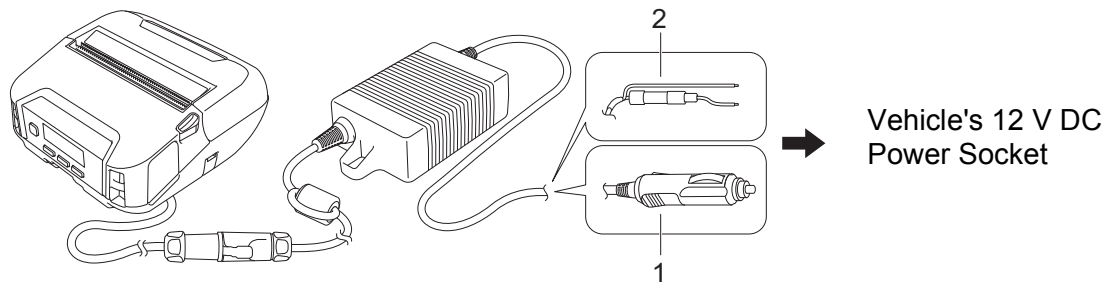
The plugs are polarized to ensure correct installation. They can only be connected one way. DO NOT attempt to force a connection.

Connect the Battery Eliminator to the Vehicle Power Supply

Connect the Battery Eliminator to your vehicle's 12 V DC power socket (cigarette lighter or similar).

- 1 Connect the Cigarette Socket Adapter or the Bare Wire Connector into the vehicle's 12 V DC power socket.



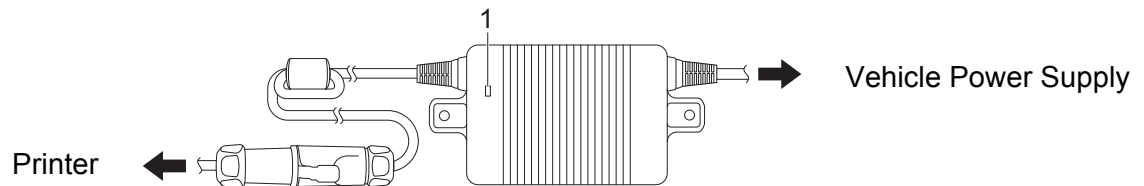
- 1 Cigarette Socket Adapter
- 2 Bare Wire Connector



Note

If installing the Bare Wire Connector type, follow good wiring practices and connect it to a fused connection point on the vehicle electrical fuse block. The positive lead (red wire) contains the fuse holder.

- 2 Check that the LED indicator of the Power Adapter is lit in green.

Note

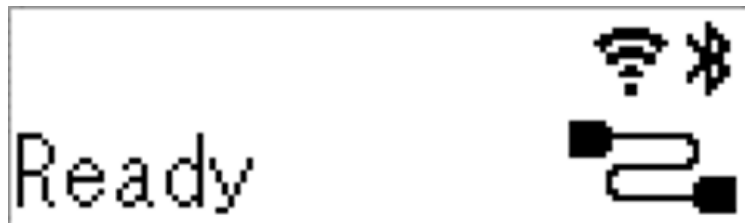
If the LED is lit in red:

- a) Disconnect the printer from the power supply.
- b) Turn off the vehicle power.
- c) Reconnect the printer to the power supply.

If the LED color is still red, contact your local Brother dealer.

Connect the Battery Eliminator to the Vehicle Power Supply

- 3 Turn on the printer. The connection icon appears on the printer's LCD when the Battery Eliminator is connected.



- 4 Install the correct media in the printer.
- 5 Press the **Feed** button to check that the printer is correctly connected and the media has been correctly installed.



Note

The printer can print only if the vehicle power is on.
