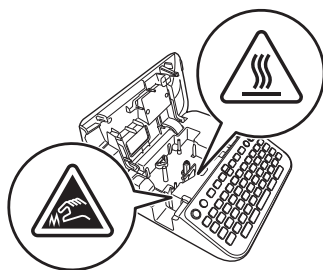

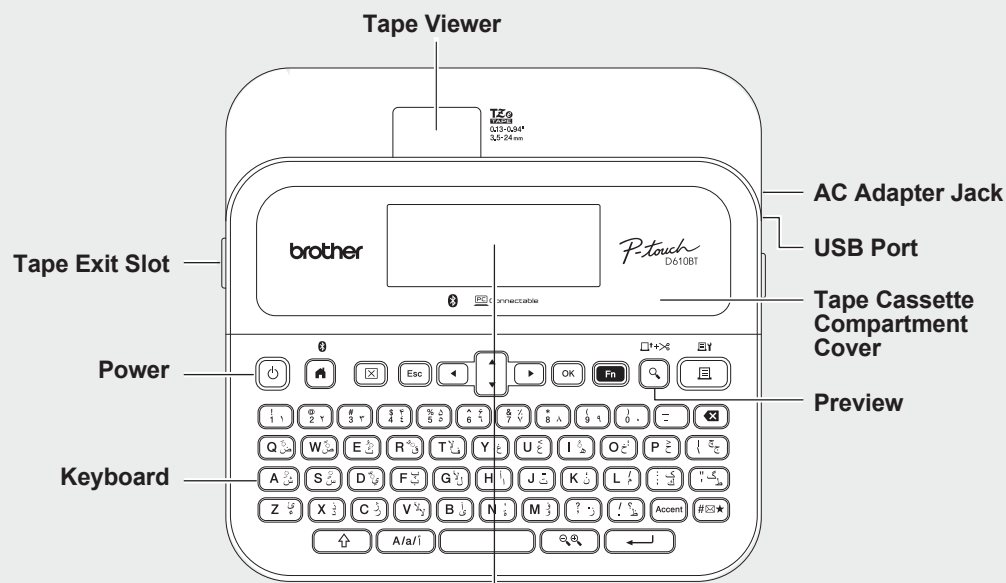

#### **Label Printer, USB Cable, AC Adapter, Alkaline Batteries**

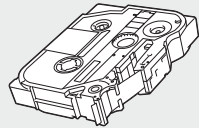
- Use only the specified AA alkaline batteries (LR6).
- DO NOT use combinations of old and new batteries or combinations of different types, charging levels, manufacturers, or models.
- DO NOT drop the Label Printer when removing it from the box or relocating it, otherwise you may get injured.
- Be careful when closing the Tape Cassette Compartment Cover. There is a risk of injury if your finger gets pinched between the upper and lower parts of the cover.
- When you are not using the Label Printer, store it out of the reach of children. In addition, do not allow children to put the Label Printer parts or labels in their mouths. If any object has been swallowed, seek medical attention immediately.
- DO NOT leave the Label Printer or any tape within the reach of babies and children.
- Store the Label Printer on a flat, level, and stable surface.
- Remove the batteries and disconnect the AC Adapter if you do not intend to use the printer for an extended period of time.

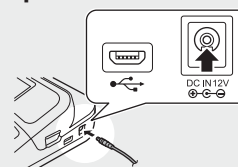
## 2. Install Batteries or Connect the AC Adapter

Remove the protective material (first use only) before using the Label Printer.

### AC Adapter



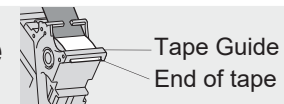
- When using the AC Adapter (AD-E001A):
  - Insert the Adapter cord connector into the AC Adapter Jack on the side of the printer.
  - Insert the plug into the nearest standard electrical socket. For memory backup, we recommend using AA alkaline batteries (LR6) together with the AC Adapter.
- To safeguard and back up the Label Printer's memory, when the AC Adapter is unplugged, keep AA alkaline batteries (LR6) installed in the Label Printer.
- When power is disconnected for more than two minutes, all text and format settings will be cleared. Any text files stored in the memory will also be cleared.
- Remove the batteries if you do not intend to use the Label Printer for an extended period of time.
- Dispose of the batteries at an appropriate collection point, not in the general waste stream. In addition, be sure to observe all applicable federal, state, and local regulations.
- When storing or discarding the batteries, wrap them (for example with cellophane tape), to prevent them from short-circuiting.

(Battery insulation example)

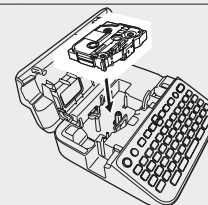
1. Cellophane tape

## 3. Insert the Tape Cassette



- After the tape passes under the Tape Guide, pull the tip to remove any slack in the tape.
- Make sure the tape is not caught in the Label Printer when inserting or removing the Tape Cassette.



1. Insert the Tape Cassette following the illustration under the Tape Cassette Compartment Cover. Confirm that the tip of the tape is pointed at the Tape Exit Slot.
2. Press the Tape Cassette into the Label Printer until it locks into place, and then close the Tape Cassette Compartment Cover.

## 4. Turn the Power ON or OFF

**Power on** Press .

**Power off** Press and hold until the Label Printer turns off.

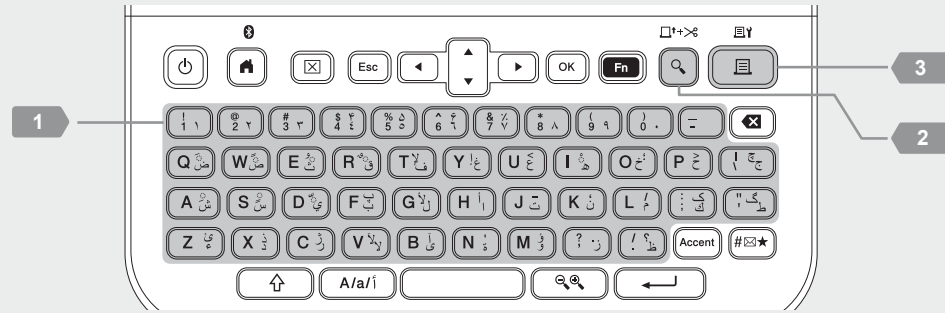

## 2. Print from Your Computer

### Windows


In your browser's address bar, type [install.brother](http://install.brother) and download and install the Printer Driver and P-touch Editor by following the on-screen instructions.

### Mac

Download P-touch Editor from the App Store to print from your Mac. You do not need to download and install any drivers.



- When printing from your computer, you must connect the Label Printer and computer with the included USB Cable or via Bluetooth connection.
- This Label Printer does not support Wi-Fi connections.

Software	Features
<b>Printer Driver</b>	Software required to print from a Label Printer using a Windows computer.
 <b>P-touch Editor</b>	Label creation software for computers. This application comes with built-in drawing tools that allow you to print a wide variety of custom labels in complex layouts with text of different fonts and styles, frames, imported images, barcodes, and more.

## 3. Print from Your Mobile Device

### Application Installation

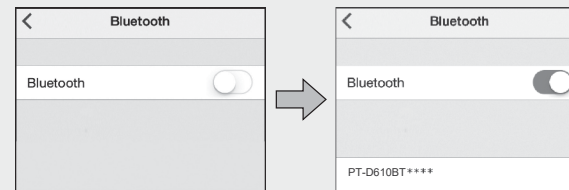


To save tape, enable the Chain Printing setting in Brother iPrint&Label. Print your labels and leave the last label in the Label Printer until you are ready to print a new label.

### To Enable or Disable Bluetooth

1. Check that the printer is on.
2. Press **[Home]** → **[Left]** → **[Settings]** → **[OK]** / **[Left]** → **[Bluetooth]** → **[OK]** / **[Left]** → **[Bluetooth (On/Off)]** → **[OK]** / **[Left]** → **[On]/[Off]** → **[OK]** / **[Left]**

### Pair the Label Printer with Your Mobile Device via Bluetooth



1. Go to your mobile device's settings menu and enable the Bluetooth option.
2. Use the pairing number displayed on the Application Download Label attached to the front of the Label Printer.

- If the printer prompts you to enter a PIN, enter "0000".
- Pairing instructions may differ slightly, depending on your mobile device.
- If your mobile device cannot discover the printer via Bluetooth, check the following:
  - Place your mobile device as close as possible to the Label Printer.
  - Make sure there are no obstacles or items that emit radio waves, such as a microwave oven, between the Label Printer and your mobile device.
- If a Bluetooth pass key appears on the Label Printer's LCD during pairing, make sure your mobile device displays the same Bluetooth pass key, and then press **[OK]**.
- This Label Printer does not support Wi-Fi connections.

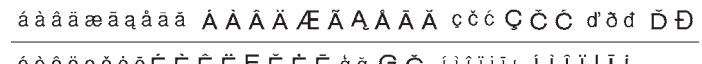

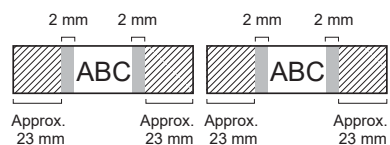

## Set Margins

By default the printer creates a laminate margin of approx. 23 mm at the beginning of each label. To reduce this margin, print multiple labels continuously. You can also change the margin before and after the text for the second and subsequent labels when printing multiple labels. Select [Chain] to print labels with the narrowest margin width. **DO NOT** feed the tape until the final label is printed. When the final label prints, cut it manually using the [Feed & Cut] function.

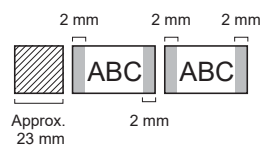

## Error Messages

Message	Cause/Remedy
Incorrect no. of digits	The number of digits entered in the barcode data does not match the number of digits set in the barcode parameters. Enter the correct number of digits.
Cutter malfunction	If the tape is jammed in the Cutter unit, remove the tape. Turn the Label Printer off and then on again before continuing.
Label too long	The printed label length using the text entered is longer than 999 mm. Edit the text so that the label length is less than 999 mm.
Text too long	The printed label length using the text entered is longer than the length setting. Edit the text to fit within the set length or change the length setting.
System error XX	Contact Brother customer service.





Problem	Solution
The Label Printer does not print.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check that the Tape Cassette is inserted correctly.</li> <li>• If the Tape Cassette is empty, replace it. To order supplies and accessories, visit <a href="http://global.brother/en/gateway">global.brother/en/gateway</a>.</li> <li>• Check that the Tape Cassette Compartment Cover is securely closed.</li> <li>• Check that the Label Printer is on.</li> <li>• Check that the computer's or mobile device's Bluetooth setting is on.</li> <li>• Check that the Label Printer is connected to your computer or mobile device via Bluetooth.</li> <li>• Check that the Label Printer is selected in the Brother iPrint&amp;Label app.</li> <li>• Check that the Label Printer is not paired with another device.</li> <li>• Make sure the Label Printer and your mobile device or computer are close enough to communicate.</li> </ul>

## Troubleshooting (cont.)

Problem	Solution
The Label Printer does not print.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check that the automatic Bluetooth re-connection setting of another computer or mobile device is not enabled.</li> <li>• Make sure no devices that emit radio waves (for example, a microwave oven) are located nearby.</li> <li>• Check that the correct printer driver is installed when printing from a Windows computer.</li> <li>• Connect the Label Printer to your computer using the USB Cable (included) when printing from a computer.</li> <li>• If the Print Head is dirty, clean it with a cotton swab or with the optional Print Head Cleaning Cassette (TZe-CL4).</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The tape does not feed correctly.</li> <li>• The tape gets stuck inside the Label Printer.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If the tape is bent, cut off the bent section with scissors.</li> <li>• If the tape is jammed, remove the Tape Cassette, remove the jammed tape, and then cut off any damaged tape with scissors.</li> <li>• Check that the end of the tape exits through the Tape Guide.</li> <li>• Confirm that the tape is pointed at the Tape Exit Slot.</li> <li>• Remove the Tape Cassette and insert it again.</li> </ul>
An error occurred when using a mobile app.	Go to your mobile application's settings menu and select <b>Support page &gt; FAQs &amp; Troubleshooting</b> .
The screen is locked, or the Label Printer does not operate normally.	See the <b>Basic Operations</b> section in this guide and reset the Label Printer's internal memory to the factory settings. If resetting the Label Printer does not solve the problem, disconnect the AC Adapter and remove the batteries for more than 10 minutes.
The LCD remains blank after turning the power on.	Check that the batteries are correctly installed or that the AC Adapter included with your Label Printer is correctly connected.
The Label Printer stops while printing a label.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Replace the Tape Cassette if striped tape is visible as this indicates that you have reached the end of the tape.</li> <li>• Replace all batteries or connect the AC Adapter directly to the Label Printer.</li> </ul>

Problem	Solution
Previously saved label files are not available.	All files saved in the internal memory are deleted if the batteries are weak or the AC Adapter is disconnected.

Problem	Solution
When the label is printed, there is too much margin (space) on both sides of the text.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>See the <i>Set Margins</i> section in this guide and select [Small Margin], [Chain] or [No Cut] for smaller margins. When you set [Small Margin], the Label Printer feeds approx. 23 mm of leader tape before every new label. To save tape, select the [Chain] setting. After the last label prints, press  and  simultaneously to feed and cut the tape.</li> <li>The Label Printer feeds approx. 23 mm of tape before every new label. When printing multiple labels, you can reduce the blank space on the second and subsequent labels. Select the [Chain] setting in the optional print settings. Then, print your labels and leave the last label in the Label Printer until you are ready to print a new label.</li> <li>After the last label prints, press  and  simultaneously to feed the tape, and then eject and cut the last label. Note that the Label Printer will feed approx. 23 mm of tape before the next new label when you use this method.</li> </ul>
I cannot update the printer's firmware using the P-touch Update Software, Transfer Express, or Mac Update Tool.	Restart the printer and then try to update the firmware again. Do not press any buttons during the firmware update.
