- 2. Place the P-touch labeler so that the cassette cover is facing upwards, then open the cassette cover.





Do not put your finger inside the tape exit slot. You could be injured by the cutter blade.

3. Insert a tape cassette and close the cassette cover. Restore the P-touch labeler to an upright position.


Always replace all six batteries at the same time using new batteries or fully charged rechargeable batteries.



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### How can I prevent about 1-inch left margin produced before printing? (P-touch Editor 5.x)

Due to the design and construction of the tape mechanism, it is essential to feed a certain amount of tape through the machine before the first label. However, by printing labels consecutively, subsequent labels can be printed without this excess tape.

The following methods are useful for reducing tape use:

> Reducing the tape margins

Printing more than one label consecutively:

- > Using the same layout style for multiple copies
- > Using different layout styles

#### Reducing the tape margins



- 1. Click Paper on the command bar.
- 2. Select [Tape size] [Margins] to adjust the margin.





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# The top and base layers of the laminated tape are misaligned.

Make sure the underside of the tape cassette is completely touching the base of the compartment.

If the tape is not installed correctly, the top and base layers of the laminated tape become misaligned, as shown in the picture below.




This can be corrected by feeding. Please follow the steps below.




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
# Poor print quality when printing on narrow labels. (iPrint&Label)

How to set text as bold:

- 2. Tap  $[{f B}]$  in the Style tab or select any bold style you like in the Font tab.





If this doesn't solve the problem, it is recommended that you try to print on a wider tape.

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
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### How do I connect the printer to my computer via Wi-Fi®?



To connect your printer to a wireless network, you must use the supplied AC adapter or Li-ion battery. If your Brother printer is powered by alkaline or Ni-MH batteries, you cannot connect it to a wireless network.

To connect the printer and your computer:



- Connect your computer to your wireless router/access point.
  (You can skip this step if your computer is already connected to a Wi-Fi® network.)
- 2. Connect your Brother printer to the same wireless router/access point.
- 3. Connect your Brother printer and your computer.

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## What are WPA-PSK/WPA2-PSK, TKIP and AES?

WPA, short for a Wi-Fi Protected Access®, is a data encryption specification for a wireless LAN. It improves upon the security feature of WEP by using Extensible Authentication Protocol (EAP) to secure network access and an encryption method to secure data transmissions.

WPA is designed for use with an 802.1X authentication server that distributes different keys to each user. However, it can also be used in a less secure "Pre-Shared Key (PSK)" mode. PSK is designed for home and small office networks where every user has the same passphrase. WPA-PSK is also called WPA-Personal. WPA-PSK enables the Brother wireless machine to associate with access points using TKIP or AES encryption method. WPA2-PSK enables the Brother wireless machine to associate with access points using AES encryption method.

TKIP (short for Temporal Key Integrity Protocol) is an encryption method. TKIP provides per-packet key mixing a message integrity and re-keying mechanism.

AES (short for Advanced Encryption Standard) is the Wi-Fi® authorized strong encryption standard.

WPA-PSK/ WPA2-PSK and TKIP or AES use a Pre-Shared Key (PSK) that is 8 or more characters in length, up to a maximum of 63 characters.

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
## What is WEP?

WEP is short for Wired Equivalent Privacy, a security protocol for a wireless local area network (WLAN) defined in the IEEE 802.11b standard. WEP is designed to provide a wireless LAN with a level of security comparable to that of a wired LAN.

WEP was the standard set in 1999 and since then hackers have devised ways to exploit WEP security flaws. The most widely recommended solution to WEP security problems is to switch to WPA or WPA2. Either is much more secure than WEP.

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# Can I set the printer to turn on its wireless LAN settings when I turn on the printer?

Yes. Use Communication settings in the Printer Setting Tool to configure the printer's network settings.

### Enabling automatic wireless connections

Open the Printer Setting Tool.
 Refer to "Using the Printer Setting Tool".

### 2. Click Communication settings.

The Communication settings window appears.

3. To automatically connect the printer to a wireless network when the printer is turned on, select Wireless LAN by Default or Keep Current State for Network Settings on Power ON.

The following three settings are available for Network Settings on Power ON:

- Wireless LAN by Default: when the printer is turned on, the wireless LAN function is always on.
- Off by Default: when the printer is turned on, the wireless LAN function is always off.
- Keep Current State: when the printer is turned on, the wireless LAN function setting when the printer was last turned off is used.
- 4. Click Apply to apply the setting to the printer, and then click Exit.
- 5. Click **Exit** in the **Printer Setting Tool** window to finish specifying the setting.

- 3. Press the Feed & Cut button six times while continuing to hold down the Power button.
  - All printer settings will be reset to the factory settings.

### Resetting the communication settings

- 1. Turn off the printer.
- 2. Press and hold the Feed & Cut button while holding down the Power button.
  - The Editor Lite lamp flashes and the Status lamp is lit in orange.
- 3. Press the Feed & Cut button twice while continuing to hold down the Power button.
  - The communication settings will be reset to the factory settings.

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# Which printing modes are available?

The following modes are available for selecting when the printing starts.

### • Immediately after starting to receive data

Printing starts immediately after the printer begins receiving the printing data.

This is the default mode.

If the printing data for the next page is received before the printer finishes printing the current page, the printer will print continuously without stopping.

### After one page of data is received

Printing starts after the printing data for one page is received.



When After one page of data is received is selected, the printer will not stop during the printing of a page even if your computer is performing complex operations at the same time that are not related to printing.

To switch between the two modes above, follow the steps below:

- 1. Start P-touch Editor and select Print from the File menu.
- 2. Click Properties in the Print dialog box.



3. In the Other tab, select Immediately after starting to receive data or After one page of data is received for Start printing and click OK.



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# What options are available for label feeding and cutting?

When printing, you can select the following six options on the **Print** screen:

Auto Cut	<ul> <li>Each label is automatically cut after printing.</li> <li>When the Auto Cut and Half Cut options are selected simultaneously, only the last label will be fully cut after printing.</li> <li>The printer can also be set to cut the labels after a specified number of labels are printed.</li> </ul>
Half Cut	Only the label tape is cut without cutting the backing, making it easier to remove the label backing.
Chain Printing	When printing more than one label, the labels are printed continuously without cutting each label. After printing, the last label is stopped in that position without being cut.
Special tape (no cuts)	After printing, the label is stopped in that position without being cut.  Without using the printer's cutter after printing, remove the tape cassette from the machine and use scissors to cut the tape.
Mirror Printing	Prints a mirror image of the label.
Output Directly to Printer Driver	Sends the data directly from the application to the printer driver. (Because the printing speed has priority over the printing quality, some objects may not be printed or may appear slightly different from the actual objects when printed.)




- You may use some options simultaneously (except in the following cases).
- When you select the Special tape (no cuts) option, the Auto Cut, Half Cut and Chain Printing options will be disabled even if they were selected.
   When you use TZe tape (non-laminated) and select the Half Cut option, the Half Cut option will be disabled and the Auto Cut option will be selected instead.

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# Can I print a label at a high resolution?

Yes. Create a label using P-touch Editor, and then follow the steps below to print the label at a high resolution.

- 1. From the File menu in P-touch Editor, click Print.
- 2. Click Properties....
- 3. In the Basic tab, select High resolution for Quality.



4. Click OK.

Now you can print the label at a high resolution.



You cannot select high resolution when printing on fabric tape. For more information about the consumables for your printer, refer to the Consumables section of this website.



- The initial Network Name could be the manufacturer's name or the model name.

### Function settings of your WLAN access point


Depending on the WLAN access point being used, some functions of WLAN access point/router may cause interference to wireless communication between your computer and the printer. See the instructions supplied with your WLAN access point/router and confirm your function settings. If the following functions are enabled, please change the setting.

### Multiple SSID

This function allows you to configure multiple SSIDs with one WLAN access point/router. Each SSID can use different authentication and encryption methods so that you can connect wireless devices to the wireless network at different security levels at the same time. However, if you want to connect all wireless devices to a specific wireless network, these devices have to use the same SSID. In many cases, devices using different SSID cannot communicate with each other, and cannot send or receive data through the same wireless network. Configure your wireless computer and printer with the same SSID as used for your WLAN access point/router.








### Privacy Separator

Privacy Separator isolates all wireless devices connected to your WLAN access point/router, and prevents the wireless devices from being able to connect and send data to other devices in your wireless network.

When Privacy Separator is on, wireless devices such as your computer and your printer will not be able to communicate with each other. To connect your printer to the other devices, please change the setting of your WLAN access point/router and disable Privacy Separator.





### MAC address filtering

MAC address filtering is a function that allows only specific MAC address configured in the WLAN access point/ router to connect. If you are using MAC address filtering in the WLAN access point/ router, you need to configure your MAC address of your printer.

You can find your printer's MAC Address by checking the Communication settings in the Printer Setting Tool or by printing the Printer Configuration. Click here to see the details of how to find your printer's network settings.

### IP address allocation

### Assigning Static IP addresses

Before you assign the IP address manually using Static mode, please read the following. The IP address which you wish to assign to your printer.

- Must be chosen from outside the range of the IP address that might be assigned as a dynamic address by DHCP server.
- Must be different from the one that has been already assigned to another device in your network.
- Must be on the same network as your computer and the WLAN access point/router.



If the IP address assigned to your computer is 192.168.1.xx, assign any number which has not assigned to other devices to where xx is (e.g. 192.168.1.10). The first three series of numbers (192.168.1 as shown in the example) must be the same.

#### . Assigning IP address automatically

If your WLAN access point/router does not support a DHCP server function, the IP address can not be automatically configured. For more information, see the documentation supplied with your WLAN access point/router.

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


## How do I print labels distributed to multiple printers?


When printing a large number of labels, printing can be distributed among multiple printers. Since printing is performed at the same time, the total printing time can be reduced.



- Printing can be distributed to printers connected via a USB connection or wireless network connection.
- The number of pages to be printed is automatically divided among the selected printers. If the specified number of pages cannot be evenly divided among the printers, it will be divided in the order of the printers listed in the dialog box when the print settings are specified in step 4.



- 1. From the File menu in P-touch Editor, click Print.
- 2. Click Properties....
- 3. Select the Advanced tab, select the Distributed Printing check box, and then click Settings



4. In the Distributed Printing Settings dialog box, select the printers to be used for distributed printing.



- a. Click Detect Current Paper Information....
- b. The current printer information that was detected appears below Current Width and Paper Type.
- c. Select the check box beside the Printer Name to be used for distributed printing.





## · Import from the current computer wireless settings

Imports the settings from the computer.



- Only personal security authentication settings (open system, public key authentication and WPA/WPA2-PSK) can be imported. Enterprise security authentication (such as LEAP and EAP-FAST) and WPA2-PSK (TKIP+AES) settings cannot be imported.
- If multiple wireless LANs are enabled for the computer being used, the first wireless settings (only personal settings) that are detected will be considered for the import data.
- Only settings (communication mode, SSID, authentication method, encryption mode and authentication key) from the Wireless LAN tab Wireless Settings pane can be imported.

## Select a Profile to import

Imports the exported file and applies the settings to a printer.

## Head or motor is cooling down

The print head or motor is too hot.

# Print head:

If the print head becomes too hot, it may produce imaging on the paper in areas not intended to be printed. This condition is normal when printing a large number of documents with a high print density. The printer will stop, then resume printing after the print head has cooled down.

To avoid or delay the onset of this condition, print using a lighter density setting, reduce the amount of black areas being printed (for example, remove background shading and colors in graphs and presentation documents). Also, make sure that the printer has adequate ventilation and is not located in an enclosed space.

## Motor:

If the printer is used continuously, the motor will become too hot. In this case, the printer will stop and resume printing after the motor has cooled down.



This condition may occur more often when the printer is used at a high altitude (above 3,048 m / 10,000 feet) due to the lower air density available to cool the printer.

## Error 1 has occurred.

- Is the correct cassette installed?
   Check that the correct type and size of tape is installed. For more information, see "Which kind of tapes can I use?"
- Is the cassette installed correctly?

  If not, remove the cassette, and then reinstall it. For more information, see "How do I set a tape cassette?"
- Is there enough tape remained?
   If not, install a new cassette.
- Is the cassette cover open?

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# P-touch Editor sometimes crashes. (For Office 2013 or 2016 users)

If you update Office to the 2013 or 2016 version with the "Add-in" setting on, P-touch Editor sometimes crashes. Please update P-touch Editor to the latest version from the [Downloads] section of this website.

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## The printed label contains blank horizontal lines.

A blank horizontal line or poor-quality characters on printed labels generally indicate that the print head is dirty. Clean the print head using a cotton swab or optional print head cleaning cassette (TZ-CL4).



Do not touch the print head directly with your bare hands.

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# When I search for devices using Mobile Cable Label Tool, Brother iPrint&Label or Mac, the printer cannot be detected.

You need to update to the latest firmware.

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# How can I minimize the margin from the start or end of the label when printing? (iPrint&Label)

You can minimize the tape margin by turning the [Chain Printing] setting ON on the editing screen of iPrint&Label. (It is effective for printing multiple labels.)

The procedure is as follows.


- 1. Edit the labels using iPrint&Label.
- 2. Tap [**PRINT**].
- 3. Swipe the toggle button for [Chain Printing] under [Cut Options] to turn it ON. If there is [Auto Cut], turn it OFF.
- 4. Tap the [PRINT] button.



To prevent the tape from being cut in the middle of the text, be sure to feed the tape before you cut it.



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# The printer stops while printing, or the tape is cut in the middle of the text.

When the printer stops while printing, or the tape is cut in the middle of the text, perform the following steps to feed the tape.

- 1. Confirm that the printer is ON.
- 2. Press the [Feed&Cut] button. The tape feeds automatically.



The following settings in the applications can prevent the printer from stopping while printing. (If you want to reduce margin to the minimum, perform the steps above without doing the settings below.)

### For Brother iPrint&Label:

Tap [Print] and then turn [Chain Printing] in the Cut Option OFF.



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# P-touch Editor displays "There is no printer driver installed with this application." (for Windows 10)



If you receive this error, your printer may have been incorrectly detected by your computer. Do the following:

- 1. Click the Start Menu > (All apps) > Windows System > Control Panel > Hardware and Sound > Devices and Printers.
- 2. Check if your printer is listed as an unspecified device.




If the printer is not listed in **Devices and Printers**, make sure that :

- •The printer is turned on.
- •The printer is connected to the computer via USB.
- 3. Right-click the printer listed as an unspecified device, and then click Remove device.

### If you cannot save any files from [File] - [Save to Web]:

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
## The label does not cut well.

If the label does not cut well or tape is jammed in the cutter, tape adhesive may have built up on the cutter blades after repeated use. To correct this problem, the tape cutter must be cleaned.

### Cleaning the tape cutter

Wipe the cutter blades using a dry cotton swab.

• Frequent cleaning is recommended.



- 1. Cotton swab
- 2. Cutter blades



Do not touch the cutter blades with your finger.

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# I cannot use P-touch Editor Lite. (For macOS 10.15 or later)

P-touch Editor Lite is not compatible with macOS 10.15 or later. You need to install the Printer Driver (available only for macOS 10.15) and P-touch Editor on your computer. For the information about the Printer Driver and P-touch Editor, go to the [Downloads] section of this website.

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

### STEP 1: Check the connection between your printer and the computer

- i. Make sure that the printer is turned on.
- ii. Make sure that both ends of the USB cable are correctly inserted into the computer and the printer.
  - Try disconnecting and reconnecting the USB cable at both ends. Disconnect the printer and the computer and reconnect them.
  - Try another USB port if available.
  - If you are using a USB hub, remove it and connect the printer directly to the computer. Depending on the model of the USB Hub, the printer may not be correctly detected.
  - Use a USB cable no longer than 6 feet long (2 meters).
  - Try another USB cable if available.
  - If you are using a network model, make sure that you have not accidentally connected the USB cable to the LAN port instead of the USB port.
- iii. Make sure that the Editor Lite mode is disabled.







**Incremented by**: increase per count **Count**: number of entries per series

For example, when setting [Incremented by] to "1" and [Count] to "4", the labels will be serialized as follows: P1 P2 P3 P4.





To serialize multiple selected ranges, select the [Advanced serialize] check box, and then specify the necessary items.

5. Tap [DONE]. The contents set in step 4 appear in the [Database] list.



Shape (Poly/Rect) Table Group Frame Background Symbol Picture Making Calendar Arrange Text	Not editable. (Only printing is possible.)
Cutline	The cutline position setting of P-touch Editor is not available in Pro Label Tool.
Multiple sheets	If your label layout created in P-touch Editor contains multiple sheets, only the first sheet is available in Pro Label Tool.

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# P-touch Editor crashes when I open it on my Mac.

P-touch Editor may crash if your Mac has custom fonts installed.

1. Disable custom fonts in the Font Book.



 $Custom \ fonts \ are \ usually \ stored \ in \ the \ [\textbf{User}] \ folder \ in \ the \ Font \ Book. \ If \ necessary, \ you \ can \ enable \ them \ in \ the \ Font \ Book \ later.$ 

- 2. Open P-touch Editor.
- 3. If you still cannot open P-touch Editor, go to the Font Book > [File] > [Restore Standard Fonts].
- 4. Your Mac will automatically back up the custom fonts, and then will restore the standard fonts. Restart P-touch Editor.
